Mrs. Keeton called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

EXCELSIOR COLLEGE – JOSH BELINFANTE

A brief discussion was held regarding correspondence Josh Belinfante presented to Board for review.

Flynn moved to refer correspondence presented to the Board from Josh Belinfante to the Attorney General's Office for memorandum of legal advice. Cranfill seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PETITION WAIVER – NOLAN TETER

Cranfill moved to accept documentation as presented and grant rules waiver. There was no second therefore the motion did not carry.

Taylor moved to request applicant to provide additional information regarding job duties as a RN in the facility. Flynn seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PETITION WAIVER – VIVIAN CARNEGIE

Flynn moved to deny petition waiver due to action in another jurisdiction. Thigpen seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS – CORRECTION OF MOTION SHEETS

Taylor moved to rescind the previous board motion and amend the November 18-19, 2009 Board minutes on page 14 to change the "November 18th" to the "November 19th" under Cease and Desist. Flynn seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Taylor moved to amend the January 13-14, 2010 board meeting minutes on page 14 under the heading Cease and Desist to change "adverting" to "advertising." Anderson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

OFFICE GENERATED REPORTS – ADRIENNE PRICE

RNI100692 – Flynn moved to rescind previous Board motion and refer to Legal Services for a Private Consent Agreement for failure to disclose arrests with a fine of \$500. Anderson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI080512 – Flynn moved to rescind the previous board motion and refer to the Attorney General's Office for a Hearing or a Public Consent Order to include probation for four (4) years, substance abuse stipulations, narcotic restrictions for two (2) years, quarterly reports-employer, aftercare & personal, a fine of \$500 for failure to disclose arrests and a fine of \$50 for unlicensed practice. Taylor seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI100580 – Anderson moved to rescind previous board motion and refer to the Attorney General's Office for a Hearing or a Public Consent Order to include probation for three (3) years, substance abuse stipulations, narcotic restrictions for (2) two years, quarterly reports-employer, aftercare & personal. Applicant must complete a board approved re-entry program; while in reentry, no narcotic restrictions and must have (2) two random 10-panel drug screens per month. Taylor seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI100754 – Taylor moved to rescind the previous board motion and refer to the Attorney General's Office for a Hearing or a Public Consent Order to include probation terminating July 14, 2012, substance abuse stipulations, narcotic restrictions for (6) six months, quarterly reports-employer, aftercare & personal. Anderson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI100748 – Taylor moved to rescind the previous board motion and refer to the Attorney General's Office for a Hearing or a Public Consent Order to include probation for four (4) years, substance abuse stipulations, narcotic restrictions for two (2) years, quarterly reports-employer, aftercare & personal and must inform the Board of completion of criminal probation. Anderson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI100691 – Anderson moved to rescind previous board motion to include instructing staff to report denial of licensure to HIPDB, NURSIS and the LPN Board. Cranfil seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI100568 – Taylor moved to deny licensure based public action in another jurisdiction. Flynn seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RNI100836 – Flynn moved to refer to Legal Services for a Private Consent Agreement for failure to disclose arrests with a fine of \$500 and \$50 for unlicensed practice.

RNI100612 – Anderson moved to rescind the previous board motion and proceed with licensure by examination. Cranfil seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

REVISION OF APPLICATION DISCIPLINARY QUESTION

Taylor moved to accept staff recommendations regarding the revised language to the disciplinary question in the online application. Flynn seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
