Ms. Lockwood called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m. on Friday, May 24, 2013. A quorum to conduct disciplinary matters was determined to exist.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Ms. Fletcher moved, Ms. Hedenstrom seconded and the Board voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§43-1-2 (k); 43-1-19 (h); 43-26-5 (c) and 43-26-11, to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative cases and pending cases. The motion passed unanimously.

At the conclusion of Executive Session on Friday, May 24, 2013, Ms. Lockwood declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

APPLICATION REVIEW

(LPNI = Licensed Practical Nurse Investigative Case Number)

Applicant C.C. #1801693 – Ms. Fletcher moved to request the applicant to submit updated refresher documentation, and upon completion of 80/160 refresher, proceed with licensure. The applicant must not provide LPN care while not licensed and must have some Med/Surg hours as part of the refresher. Ms. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE

(LPNI – Licensed Practical Nurse Investigative Case Number)

LPNI100267 – Ms. Fletcher moved to close the case and renew license. Ms. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

LPNI120074 – Ms. Hedenstrom moved to renew license. Renewal does not mean that further sanctions will not be forthcoming. Ms. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.



LPNI130190 – Ms. Fletcher moved to refer to Legal Services for a hearing or public consent order to include five (5) years probation, substance abuse stipulations, two (2) years narcotic restrictions and quarterly reports (employer, aftercare, personal and psychotherapy) based on MPE and criminal conviction. Ms. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
