Mann called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m. on Tuesday, August 12, 2014.

### EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mann moved, Fletcher seconded and the Committee voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k); 43-1-19(h), 43-26-5(c) and 43-26-11, for the purpose of discussing investigative cases and to conduct investigative interviews. The motion passed unanimously.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Tuesday, August 12, 2014, Mann declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

### INVESTIGATIVE COMMITTEE CASES

Mann moved to present the following recommendations to the Board.

LPNI130098 – Close the case.

LPNI130179 – Close the case.

RNI140250 – Rescind the previous motion and refer for a private consent agreement to include courses in Professional Accountability, Documentation, Sharpening Critical Thinking Skills and Nurse Practice Act and a fine of \$100 for unlicensed practice.

LPNI140018 – Refer for a private reprimand requiring courses in Professional Accountability, Documentation and Medication Administration.

RNI140029 – Must submit reentry plan for approval. If approved, refer for a private consent agreement to include five (5) years probation, alcohol/drug screens biweekly for twelve (12) months, random screens after that for 12 months, two (2) years narcotic restriction, individual therapy session or group with AA/GNA IP and quarterly reports (employer, aftercare and personal).

RNI120311 – Deny renewal and refer to the Attorney General's Office for a hearing.

RNI130627 – Mitigating letter requesting courses in Medication Administration, Documentation and Professional Accountability.

RNI100262 – Refer for a public board order to include five (5) years probation, two (2) years narcotic restriction and quarterly reports (employer, aftercare, personal and psychotherapy).

RNI120714 – Schedule Investigative Interview. The respondent must bring counselor or reports from counselor documenting aftercare and other missing quarterly reports.

RNI140593 – Refer for a private consent order to include a fine of \$500 for failure to disclose.

LPNI140021 – Refer for a public reprimand to include courses in Medication Administration, Sharpening Critical Thinking Skills, Ethics and Professional Accountability and a fine of \$500 for unprofessional conduct.

LPNI140048 – Close the case.

RNI150023 – Close the case.

RNI140126 – Close the case.

RNI140256 – Refer for an MPE.

LPNI140133 – Close the case with a Letter of Concern re: Substandard Care.

RNI140610 – Rescind previous motion and refer for a public board order to include five (5) years probation, two (2) years narcotic restriction and quarterly reports (employer, aftercare, personal and psychotherapy). The respondent may use naltrexone as prescribed by treating physician.

LPNI140092 – Refer for an MPE

RNI150062 – Deny licensure until probation in Alabama is completed.

LPNI140123 – Refer for a private reprimand to include courses in Patient Rights, Ethics and Professional Accountability.

LPNI140131 – Close the case with a Letter of Concern re: Drugs.


RNI140551 – Close the case.

RNI140331 – Refer for a public board order to include five (5) years probation, two (2) years narcotic restriction, quarterly reports (employer, aftercare, personal and psychotherapy) and a fine of \$70.50 for investigative costs.

RNI140615 – Close the case with a Letter of Concern re: Alcohol.
