Rowe called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 16, 2014. A quorum to conduct disciplinary matters was determined to exist.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Barton moved, Lockwood seconded and the Board voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§43-1-2(k); 43-1-19(h); 43-26-5(c) and 43-26-11, to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative cases and pending cases. The motion passed unanimously.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Tuesday, December 16, 2014, Rowe declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.


EDUCATION REPORT


and Rowe opposing.
