RNI140635 – Barnett moved that, upon receipt of documentation from treating physician listing all current medications and stating that licensee is weaned off Suboxone and is safe to practice nursing with reasonable skill and safety, refer to the Attorney General's office for a public consent order to include three (3) years probation, two (2) years narcotics restriction, random monthly screens for twelve (12) months and quarterly random drug screens thereafter, quarterly reports (employer, personal, aftercare, psychotherapy) and substance abuse stipulations. A temporary permit for reentry may be issued upon docketing of the order. Shilling seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Shilling moved, Barton seconded and the Board voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k); 43-1-19(h), 43-26-5(c) and 43-26-11, to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative reports and pending cases. The motion passed unanimously.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Thursday, March 26, 2015 Rowe declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

CASE REVIEW

(RNI=Registered Nurse Investigative Case Number, LPNI=Licensed Practical Nurse Investigative Case Number)

RNI140297JW – Shilling moved to deny the license. Licensee may reapply after completion of all terms of criminal probation and supervision. Barnett seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE

(RNI=Registered Nurse Investigative Case Number, LPNI=Licensed Practical Nurse Investigative Case Number)

RNI130596 – Shilling moved to refer to the Attorney General's office for a private consent order to include twelve (12) months monitoring, monthly random drug screens and quarterly reports (personal, employer). Scott seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

STRATEGIC PLAN REVIEW

The Board reviewed Objective Three from the 2014-2016 Strategic Plan regarding the identification of new committees and the development of committee charges. Board members discussed the need for board member liaisons for the Nursing Education and Advanced Practice Registered Nurse ("APRN") Committees. Cleghorn will chair both committees. Rowe and Lockwood will serve as board member liaisons to the Nursing Education Committee. Shilling and Scott will serve as board member liaisons to the APRN Committee.

The Board developed the following charges for the Nursing Education Committee:

- 1) Review existing education rules make recommendations for necessary updates
- 2) Review language to change site visit schedule and board approval dates to align with national nursing accreditation visits
- 3) Review language to require national nursing accreditation for all nursing education programs by a date certain
- 4) Review language to require SACS accreditation for any developing nursing education program

5) Review NCSBN resources for innovative nursing education and make recommendations for implementation of accepted practices

The Board developed the following charges for the APRN Committee:

- 1) Review existing rules make recommendations for necessary updates
- 2) Review model rules developed by NCSBN for APRNs

The Board reviewed Objective Four from the 2014-2016 Strategic Plan regarding the review and revision of the disciplinary processes of the Board. Board members discussed the proposed legal/disciplinary grid. Barton provided an update regarding the committee's work on the grid. An updated draft will be presented at the May 2015 meeting.

The Board discussed the proposed position statement on the use of abstinence-based model for recovery for nurses with substance abuse disorder.

USE OF ABSTINENCE-BASED MODEL FOR RECOVERY FOR NURSES WITH SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDER

Shilling moved to adopt the position statement for Use of Abstinence-Based Model for Recovery For Nurses with Substance Abuse Disorder.

The Georgia Board of Nursing ("Board") supports the use of an abstinence-based model for recovery for nurses with substance abuse challenges. The data supports health care practitioners are successful with this model of recovery. Therefore, the Board has taken the following position for nurses returning to clinical practice who are actively on Buprenorphine maintenance therapy.

1. Nurses with substance abuse issues who are under treatment may not return to clinical practice until Buprenorphine therapy has been discontinued. Once cleared from Buprenorphine maintenance therapy, the nurse may be allowed to return to clinical practice with a consent order and monitoring for the appropriate period of time as determined by the Board.

The Buprenorphine maintenance therapy would include any partial U- opioid agonist (Buprenorphine—Subutex), u-opioid agonist with a K-receptor antagonist (Buprenorphine with Naloxone--Suboxone) or full u-opioid agonist (Methodone—Dolophine).

The Board has adopting the following position statement/guideline related to the use of opiate antagonist therapy and returning of the nurse to practice under consent order and monitoring guidelines.

2. Nurses with substance abuse issues who are under treatment with an opiate antagonist therapy drug may be considered to return to clinical practice under consent order with restrictions related to narcotics as the case deems appropriate. Nurses on the opiate antagonist therapy must be under care of a treating MD specializing in addictionology. Examples of drugs in this category include, but are not limited to: Naltrexone (Revia, Vivitrol, Addex). However, additional monitoring and restrictions may be added to the consent order related to this treatment regime.

Each substance abuse case will be reviewed individually based on the merits of the case. Alterations to this position statement may be made at the discretion of the Board based on individual review of each case, but must be clearly delineated with treatment requirements of a treating physician specializing in addictionology.

Barnett seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Shilling moved, Barnett seconded and the Board voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k); 43-1-19(h), 43-26-5(c) and 43-26-11, to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative reports and pending cases. The motion passed unanimously.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Thursday, March 26, 2015 Rowe declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

PRIVATE CONSENT AGREEMENTS FOR UNLICENSED AND UNAUTHORIZED PRACTICE

(LPNI = Licensed Practical Nurse Investigative Case Number) (RNI=Registered Nurse Investigative Case Number)

Barton moved to ratify the Private Consent Agreements for unlicensed/unauthorized practice that were issued according to the Board's policies.

RNI150969 RNI150970

Lockwood seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

STRATEGIC PLAN REVIEW

The Board continued the discussion of Objective Four from the 2014-2016 Strategic Plan regarding the review and revision of the disciplinary processes of the Board. The Board directed the staff to include the investigative costs in all disciplinary orders.

NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT

The Board discussed the final language from the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (“NCSBN”) for the revised Nurse Licensure Compact and the APRN Compact. Cleghorn provided an overview of changes to the Compact. Board members discussed the potential financial impact. Board members discussed the current licensure requirements for graduates of nontraditional nursing education programs and how they would be impacted by the adoption of the Nurse Licensure Compact. Cleghorn provided information regarding proposed financial support from NCSBN for the implementation of the Compact. The Board will vote at the April 23, 2015 teleconference on whether or not to support the Nurse License Compact and the APRN Compact at the NCSBN Special Delegate Assembly on May 3, 2015 in Chicago.

LISA DURDEN – DIRECTOR, PROFESSIONAL LICENSING BOARDS DIVISION

Rowe welcomed Durden and provided visitors with an overview of the topics that are typically discussed. Barton inquired about the Professional Licensing Boards Division Call Center. She noted that the Board had the opportunity to meet with Call Center Manager Stephanie Aponte at the January 2015 meeting. Durden stated that significant training had been conducted with call center staff and noted that it was a heavy time of year for call volume due to the March 31st LPN license renewals and upcoming graduations. Durden provided information on some of the training tools used by the Call Center staff. She explained that the Call Center staff were using a new ticketing system from Support Central and noted that the Board would be able to obtain informational reports from the new system. Barton expressed interest in scheduling a board member tour of the Call Center. Cleghorn will schedule the tour of the Call Center and other PLB departments as part of the May 2015 meeting. Durden noted that the new system provided callers with an estimated wait time. She discussed a scenario where a Legislator had experienced a twenty (20) minute wait. Scott stated that she was not present at the January 2015 meeting and regretted missing the opportunity to meet Aponte. She inquired whether all Call Center staff were answering calls for nursing or if the Board had been allocated dedicated agents. Durden responded that SOS was waiting for the Legislature to pass the budget and, if possible, a two tiered system would be implemented for nursing. Callers would initially be connected with a general Call Center staff member. Depending on the complexity of the question or issue, the caller would be routed to one of two dedicated nursing Call Center staff members. Scott inquired how Call Center staff competency was measured and ensured. Durden referred to the training tools used by the Call Center staff. Rowe noted that, at the January 2015 meeting, SOS staff provided the Board with information about new Call Center staff members being brought onboard in February and March 2015. Durden was unsure of the current number of Call Center staff members but agreed to obtain the information for the Board. Shilling inquired as to whether SOS had noted a decrease in the turnover rate for Call Center staff. Durden stated that she believed the turnover rate had decreased but noted that any job of that type would have a continuous turnover rate. Durden provided information regarding the incentives utilized by Aponte for Call Center staff members. Shilling asked Cleghorn about the number of tickets received in the Board office on a daily basis. Cleghorn explained that the system reports were not currently functioning properly but that Rowe had been provided with a manual count of tickets forwarded to the Board office since January 2015. Rowe noted that the number of calls forwarded to the Board office had decreased slightly since January and expressed that the Board would be very favorable towards a two tiered Call Center structure.

Mann provided information to Durden regarding the number of cases being reviewed by the Board each month at board meetings and Investigative Committee meetings. She noted the high volume of cases being referred to the Attorney General’s office on a monthly basis. She explained that the Board was still interested in having an attorney dedicated to nursing and expressed continued interest in the use of Mercer University Law School students to help draft disciplinary orders. Durden stated that she would discuss the issue with SOS Counsel, Ryan Germany. Durden noted that two paralegals had been hired at PLB and explained that Secretary of State Kemp had indicated that PLB would consider hiring an additional attorney for the Board of Nursing once the 2016 budget had been finalized and passed by the Legislature. Shilling provided information regarding the delays that occur once the cases are referred to the Attorney General’s office. Durden inquired how many assistant attorneys general were currently working on nursing cases. Baker explained that currently, one attorney worked full time on nursing cases and three other attorneys worked part time on nursing cases. This is in addition to the work performed by Board staff to draft consent agreements for applicants with failure to

disclose and unlicensed practice. Baker questioned Durden about the PLB Legal Services supervisor position. Durden replied that the position was being reviewed by Ryan Germany, SOS Counsel.

Barton asked for clarification about the structure of the PLB Legal Services department. Durden explained that there was a senior attorney, a junior attorney and two paralegals. All PLB Legal Services staff report to Ryan Germany in Atlanta. Mann reiterated how beneficial it would be to utilize Mercer University Law students as interns. Shilling asked for an anticipated timeline for the Board being notified about whether or not an attorney would be allocated to nursing. Durden replied that the answer would be known in the next few weeks once the budget had passed the Legislature. Scott inquired about the performance measures used by the agency to determine the allocation of resources. Durden noted that the attorneys were responsible for more than just drafting consent orders and agreements and explained that the attorneys also reviewed contracts, responded to open records requests and performed other functions.

Barton sought an update on the Board's request to make public disciplinary actions more visible on the licensure search feature on the Board's website. Durden stated that the issue had been referred to the software vendor and that the vendor had indicated the changes would require a technological enhancement. She explained that the agency was in the process of updating several components, including My License Office and that she hoped that the enhancement could be included in the package. She stated that the agency was still awaiting detailed information from the vendor regarding the functions that would be enhanced in the software upgrade. Rowe reiterated that the display of public disciplinary actions was very important. Durden acknowledged the importance of the project and said that it would benefit all the healthcare professions supported by the Professional Licensing Boards Division. Baker provided information regarding the display of public disciplinary actions as available on the website of the Georgia Composite Medical Board. Durden noted that the Professional Licensing Boards Division used a different software vendor. Barton and Rowe asked how the Board could help expedite the resolution to this issue. Durden explained that SOS was awaiting information from the software vendor regarding the upgrade. She noted that the vendor had wanted to deploy the upgrade sooner but that SOS had delayed the upgrade until the completion of the nursing licensure renewals to avoid unnecessary disruptions.

Shilling asked for an update regarding the PLB Mailroom/Intake department. She noted that the Board seemed to experience reoccurring scenarios where applicants or licensees submit information through the mailroom but it is never received by Board staff. She provided additional information regarding the frequency of missing items that were submitted through the mail. Durden expressed surprise and noted the increased number of staff in the Mailroom. Rowe provided information regarding a letter sent via certified mail to her work address and to Cleghorn. She explained that she received the correspondence but that Cleghorn still had not received the letter. Durden explained that mail was opened on a daily basis and sent to the Board office immediately. Baker inquired about the original copies of documents submitted through the mail. Durden explained that, currently, all documents are kept indefinitely and filed by the date which it was received.

Rowe provided information to Board members and guests regarding her February 5, 2015 meeting with Secretary of State Brian Kemp, Deputy Secretary of State Tim Fleming, Lorie Smith and Lisa Durden. Rowe explained that she requested the meeting to discuss the recommended budget prepared by the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget ("OPB"). Rowe noted that she wanted to determine if SOS interpreted OPB's recommendations the same way that the Board did. Rowe explained that Secretary Kemp provided an update regarding his efforts to improve services for both the Professional Licensing Boards Division and the Board of Nursing. Rowe noted that they discussed line 304.5 from the FY2016 proposed budget which appropriated \$670, 468 to the Professional Licensing Boards Division. After conversations with OPB, Rowe wanted to ensure that the money from that line item would be used specifically for the Board of Nursing and the costs of the mandatory reporting program. She explained to Board members and guests that the original appropriation in the FY2015 budget only identified funding for one year and that OPB had clearly stated that the appropriation in line 304.5 was intended for the Board of Nursing to continue the mandatory reporting program. Rowe noted that Secretary Kemp confirmed that the money was intended for the mandatory reporting program and that it would be utilized for Board of Nursing operations. Rowe discussed line 304.7 which provides \$513,148 to PLB and noted the potential impact on the Call Center. Rowe praised Call Center Manager Aponte and expressed appreciation for her efforts to improve the state of the PLB Call Center. She expressed further support for the planned two-tiered call center with dedicated agents for Board of Nursing inquiries. Durden stated that it was her understanding that the two-tiered Call Center plan would still be implemented if the budget was passed to include the current recommendations. Rowe noted that the information for line 304.7 did not specifically reference the Board of Nursing but that Secretary Kemp had assured her that the money would be utilized to positively impact the Board of Nursing.

Rowe expressed support for the plan to assign a dedicated attorney to the Board of Nursing. She discussed the existing bottlenecks and slowdowns that occur in the disciplinary process due to the current structure. She noted the improvements that had been made since hiring investigators specifically for the Board of Nursing and additional legal/discipline consultants but explained that

delays still occurred at the attorney level due to the volume of cases. She stated that the Board was diligently trying to work with SOS to improve Board operations at the Professional Licensing Boards Division.

Rowe discussed the transition to the Optimal Regulatory Board Software (“ORBS”) provided by NCSBN and expressed appreciation that SOS had agreed to support the transition as stated at the January 15, 2015 meeting. Rowe noted it was also discussed at her February 5, 2015 meeting with Secretary Kemp and Deputy Secretary Fleming. Durden stated that Kevin Robertson, SOS IT staff member had been tasked with coordinating with NCSBN regarding the requirements for the Board to utilize ORBS. Rowe provided information to visitors about the unique design of ORBS and how it would improve public safety.

Shilling inquired about the upgrade to the bandwidth at PLB. Durden stated that PLB had done everything needed to join the fiber optic line provided by the City of Macon and that the agency was now waiting on the City of Macon to begin the service. Durden noted the age of some components of the PLB IT infrastructure and provided information on the upgrades to some of the servers. Lockwood asked for clarification on the timeline for the upgrades. Durden estimated that the upgrades would be complete in four (4) to six (6) months.

Durden provided information regarding the 2015 LPN license renewals and noted that an additional reminder had been mailed to licensees who did not have an email address on file. Durden asked about the Board’s interest in the Nurse Licensure Compact and commented that Secretary Kemp had previously inquired about the Board’s interest in the Compact. Board members provided a brief overview of the Compact and acknowledged that participation in the Compact would improve access and support business development in Georgia.

Based on Board Rule 400-3-.04 it was recommended that Bainbridge College's LPN program be placed on conditional status. It was noted that Brenau University was currently on conditional status and that no change would be made to that program's approval status.

Moultrie Technical College

The Board received notification that Southwest Georgia Technical College and Moultrie Technical College would be merging effective July 1, 2015. The new institution will be known as Southwest Georgia Technical College.

The Board received a request from Moultrie Technical College to approve a substantive change to the practical nursing curriculum. The redesigned program would consist of one year of instruction and would not add or delete any courses required in Board Rule 400-3-.07. Based on compliance with Board Rule 400-3-.07 it was recommended that the Board approve the substantive change.

Board approval for Moultrie Technical College expired July 1, 2014. The program's four year average NCLEX-PN pass rate is 95.01%. It was recommended that the Board extend approval through December 31, 2016.

Southwest Georgia Technical College

The Board received notification that Magan Swilley has been named Director of the Practical Nursing Program at Southwest Georgia Technical College. Based on Compliance with Board Rule 400-3-.08 it was recommended that the Board approve the change.

Board approval for Southwest Georgia Technical College expired July 1, 2014. The program's four year average NCLEX-PN pass rate is 84.03%. It was recommended that the Board extend approval through December 31, 2016.

Southwest Georgia Technical College notified the Board that the program would be submitting a feasibility study for the Board to review to expand the institution's associate degree in nursing program to the Moultrie Campus.

Bauder College

The Board received notification that Terri Peterson had been named program coordinator for the associate degree in nursing program at Bauder College. Based on compliance with Board Rule 410-3-.05 it was recommended that the Board approve the change.

The Board received notification that Andrea Wilkins had been named program coordinator for the LPN program at Bauder College. Based on compliance with Board Rule 400-3-.08 it was recommended that the Board approve the change.

The current projected date for full teach-out and program closure is February 2016 which will include graduation of the last group of associate degree students.

Georgia Regents University

Georgia Regents University submitted a request for approval for revision of the curriculum for the clinical nurse leader program. Based on compliance with all applicable laws and rules, it was recommended that the Board approve the revised program curriculum plan.

Toccoa Falls College

Toccoa Falls College submitted a letter of intent and Report I for development and implementation of a bachelor of science in nursing program. Based on compliance with all applicable laws and rules, it was recommended that the Board accept and approve Report I and grant developmental approval to the program.

North Georgia Technical College

North Georgia Technical College submitted a request for approval to expand the associate degree in nursing program to its Blairsville campus. Based on compliance with all applicable laws and rules, it was recommended that the Board approve the plan for expansion of the nursing education program.

Georgia Association of Nursing Deans and Directors

Cleghorn provided a brief overview of his February 27, 2015 meeting with the Georgia Association of Nursing Deans and Directors in Savannah.

Hooper moved to approve the recommendations. Shilling seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

LEGISLATION

The Board reviewed the following bills:

House Bill 155

Provides for the creation of a vaccination registry. The bill did not pass either chamber of the Legislature and the Board took no official position on the bill.

House Bill 179

Provides for licensure requirements for pain management clinics. The bill did not pass either chamber of the Legislature and the Board took no official position on the bill.

House Bill 394

Provides for updates to the Nurse Practice. The Board requested the legislative changes and supported the Bill.

House Bill 76

Provides the FY2016 state budget. The Board reviewed the appropriations affecting the Board of Nursing.

Senate Bill 115

Provides for the delegation of authority from physicians to physician assistants. The Board reviewed correspondence related to Senate Bill 115. The bill did not pass either chamber of the Legislature and the Board took no official position on the bill. .

SCOPE OF PRACTICE

Administration of Neuromuscular Blocking Agents

The board discussed the position statement that was adopted in January 2015 on the administration of neuromuscular blocking agents. Board members reviewed correspondence regarding the current position statement, reviewed information from other jurisdictions and reviewed the current position statement on the administration of propofol. The Board will vote to amend the position statement on March 27, 2015.

Rowe called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, March 27, 2015. A quorum to conduct disciplinary matters was present.

SCOPE OF PRACTICE

Administration of Propofol, Etomidate and Neuromuscular Blocking Agents

The Board continued the discussion of the administration of neuromuscular blocking agents.

Barton moved approve the revised position statement for the administration of neuromuscular blocking agents and anesthetics as amended. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Position Statement: Administration of Propofol, Etomidate and Neuromuscular Blocking Agents

Because sedation is a continuum, it is not always possible to predict how an individual patient will respond. Due to the potential for rapid, profound changes in patient conditions during sedation/anesthesia, agents such as Propofol require special attention.

Whenever Propofol is used for sedation/anesthesia, it should be administered only by persons trained in the administration of general anesthesia, who are not simultaneously involved in the surgical or diagnostic procedure. This restriction is concordant with specific language in the Propofol package insert, and failure to follow these recommendations could put patients at increased risk of significant injury or death.

Procedural Sedation

It is not within the scope of practice of the registered nurse (RN) who is not a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA) to administer agents used primarily as anesthetics for sedation, including Propofol (American Association of Nurse Anesthetists – American Society of Anesthesiologists Joint Statement Regarding Propofol Administration, 2004). This would include the non-intubated patient undergoing procedures, including but not limited to, invasive cardiology, invasive radiology, endoscopic gastro-intestinal procedures, invasive bronchoscopy and emergent procedures.

Intubated and Mechanically Ventilated Patients in Critical Care Settings

It is within the scope of practice for the registered nurse (RN) to administer intravenous Propofol to the intubated, mechanically ventilated patient in continuous and bolus dosing, for ongoing sedation/analgesia within the Critical Care setting.

Emergency Airway Management in a Hospital Setting

The registered nurse (RN) may administer Propofol, Etomidate and neuromuscular blocking agents (only Succinylcholine and Rocuronium) to the non-intubated patient in a hospital setting for the purpose of rapid sequence intubation when the clinical presentation of impending respiratory failure is imminent. This will be done in the presence of, and under the direction of, a physician credentialed in emergency airway management.

RN Competencies

Prior to drug administration, registered nurses (RN) must demonstrate knowledge and skills which include evidence of education, training, and ongoing competency. Competencies include but may not be limited to ACLS/PALS and conscious sedation monitoring.

Abstinence Based Model for Recovery for Nurses with Substance Abuse Disorder

Barton moved to accept abstinence model for substance abuse therapy position statement. Shilling seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Position Statement: Use of Abstinence-Based Model for Recovery for Nurses with Substance Abuse Disorder

The Georgia Board of Nursing ("Board") supports the use of an abstinence-based model for recovery for nurses with substance abuse challenges. The data supports health care practitioners are successful with this model of recovery. Therefore, the Board has taken the following position for nurses returning to clinical practice who are actively on Buprenorphine maintenance therapy.

1. Nurses with substance abuse issues who are under treatment may not return to clinical practice until Buprenorphine therapy has been discontinued. Once cleared from Buprenorphine maintenance therapy, the nurse may be allowed to return to clinical practice with a consent order and monitoring for the appropriate period of time as determined by the Board.

The Buprenorphine maintenance therapy would include any partial U- opioid agonist (Buprenorphine—Subutex), u-opioid agonist with a K-receptor antagonist (Buprenorphine with Naloxone--Suboxone) or full u-opioid agonist (Methodone—Dolophine).

The Board has adopting the following position statement/guideline related to the use of opiate antagonist therapy and returning of the nurse to practice under consent order and monitoring guidelines.

2. Nurses with substance abuse issues who are under treatment with an opiate antagonist therapy drug may be considered to return to clinical practice under consent order with restrictions related to narcotics as the case deems appropriate. Nurses on the opiate antagonist therapy must be under care of a treating MD specializing in addictionology. Examples of drugs in this category include, but are not limited to: Naltrexone (Revia, Vivitrol, Addex). However, additional monitoring and restrictions may be added to the consent order related to this treatment regime.

Each substance abuse case will be reviewed individually based on the merits of the case. Alterations to this position statement may be made at the discretion of the Board based on individual review of each case, but must be clearly delineated with treatment requirements of a treating physician specializing in addictionology.

Administration of Intranasal Versed

Lockwood moved to accept the position statement on the administration of Intranasal Versed by RN/LPN in the non-clinical setting. Scott seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Position Statement: Administration of Intranasal Versed For Treatment of Signs and Symptoms of Acute Seizure Outside the Clinical Setting

It is within the scope of practice of a Registered Nurse/Licensed Practical Nurse to administer intranasal Versed (Midazolam) prescribed for the purpose of treating signs and symptoms of seizure outside the clinical setting if the following requirements are met:

- A written policy and procedure is maintained by the employer

- The nurse administering intranasal Versed (Midazolam) for treatment of signs and symptoms of seizure must possess knowledge of Versed (Midazolam) and demonstrate competency regarding administration.

Family Nurse Practitioners Practicing in Acute Care Settings

Shilling moved to approve the FNP position statement as amended. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Position Statement: Family Nurse Practitioners in Acute Care Settings

The Georgia Board of Nursing ("Board") supports the changes to the Family Nurse Practitioner ("FNP") credentialing process related to those FNPs working in the acute care environment. The following is guidance from the Board to current FNPs working in acute care:

- 1) The Board supports FNPs currently practicing in acute care settings allowing the FNP to remain employed in those settings after January 1, 2015 with the following stipulations:
 - a. FNPs must demonstrate competence in their practice setting in acute care to continue working in acute care facility assessment of practice.
 - b. FNPs not certified in Acute Care should maintain current FNP certification and current RN and APRN licenses.
 - c. FNPs not certified in acute care should obtain part of the required CEUs in care of patients in the acute care and certification renewal period. FNP should seek guidance from the certifying body as to how many hours would be needed to meet requirement.
 - d. If certification or licensure lapses, FNPs would have to become certified in Acute Care before returning to work in an acute care setting. It is most important to maintain certification and RN licensure.
 - e. The Board supports current FNPs working in acute care settings having the option to change positions or facilities in the acute care setting if qualified for the practice setting.
- 2) The Board supports the change in certification requirements for new FNPs and current FNPs not working in acute care as of January 1, 2015. Certification requirements are determined by the certifying bodies.
- 3) The Board highly recommends FNPs currently working in acute care organizations to begin the process of completing requirements to allow for meeting the full certification requirements as Acute Care NP in the future.

Lockwood moved to accept the February 19, 2015 Teleconference meeting minutes as presented. Barton seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.




Lockwood moved to accept the March 5, 2015 Investigative Committee A meeting minutes as presented. Hooper seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
