Lockwood called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 25, 2015.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Barton moved, Hooper seconded and the Committee voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k); 43-1-19(h), 43-26-5(c) and 43-26-11, to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative reports and pending cases. The motion passed unanimously.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Thursday, June 25, 2015, Lockwood declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

INVESTIGATIVE COMMITTEE CASES

(LPNI = Licensed Practical Nurse Investigative Case Number) (RNI=Registered Nurse Investigative Case Number)

Hooper moved to present the following recommendations to the Board.

LPNI150264 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for an outpatient mental physical examination from a Board approved evaluator. Results are to be reviews by the Investigative Committee and the Legal/Discipline Nurse Consultant.

LPNI130055 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for an outpatient mental physical examination from a Board approved evaluator. Results are to be reviews by the Investigative Committee and the Legal/Discipline Nurse Consultant.

RNI151009 – License with a Letter of Concern (Alcohol).

RNI151260 – Refer to the District Attorney's office for criminal prosecution.

RNI150770 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for a public consent order to include two (2) years probation, quarterly reports (personal, employer), and a fine of \$500 for unprofessional conduct.

RNI140603 – Close the case with a Letter of Concern (Ethics/Professionalism).

LPNI150530 – Close the case.

RNI150995 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for a private consent order to include five (5) years monitoring, quarterly reports (employer, personal, aftercare) and substance abuse stipulations.

LPNI130202 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for an indefinite suspension or voluntary suspension.

LPNI150540 – Must submit documentation of current criminal probation status within thirty (30) days.

RNI140154 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for an indefinite suspension or voluntary suspension.

RNI151049 – Deny the request.

LPNI150260 - TS – Refer to the Attorney General's office for a public consent order to include courses in Ethics, Professional Accountability, Boundaries and a fine of \$500 for unprofessional conduct. Must submit documentation of completion of probation.


LPNI150260 - AH – Refer to the Attorney General's office for an indefinite suspension or voluntary suspension.

RNI130103 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for a private consent order to include a fine of \$500 for Unprofessional Conduct and requiring courses in Ethics, Professional Accountability and Legal Liability, Documentation and Medication Administration. Send to Legal Services.

RNI150031 – Refer to the Attorney General's office for an indefinite suspension or voluntary suspension.

Barton seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
