

**Minutes for Used Motor Vehicle Dealers Division  
January 19, 2005**

Ms. Waldrop asked Board staff to send a letter to seminar providers to request that Pre-licensing Seminar Providers, in the future, send in 3 copies of their seminar training course outline for board review.

The Board asked Mr. Hooper to review the Ron Widener motor vehicle dealer pre-licensing course outline.

Mr. Wilkinson made a motion to reduce the Inspection Citation by failure to maintain liability insurance and six failures to post FTC "Buyer's for C & W Motors.

Mr. Riner recused himself from discussion and abstained from the vote.

Mr. Riner made a motion to accept the Voluntary Cease and Desist Order for Quincy Griggs and forward the case to the Used Motor Vehicle Parts Dealers Board.
