

**Georgia State Board of Registration of Used Motor Vehicle Dealers and
Used Motor Vehicle Parts Dealers
Meeting
May 18, 2005**

Minutes Approved at July 20, 2005 Meeting

The Georgia State Board of Registration of Used Motor Vehicle Dealers and Used Motor Vehicle Parts Dealers held their joint meeting on May 18, 2005 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia. Donny Riner, Chair of the full board, called the meeting to order at 10:05 AM.

The Board received a visit from Assistant Secretary of State Laura Meadows and Division Director Mollie Fleeman, who discussed various issues with the Board.

Mr. Lindsey announced to members that their Financial Disclosure Statement must be received in the Elections Division Office by July 1, 2005. Forms are available if needed.
