The Board discussed whether the legislative change effective July 1, 2004 allowed for a "grandfather provision" for people who had purchased salvage vehicles prior to the legislative amendment removing the allowance of three rebuilt vehicles per year before the requirement for licensure. Mr. Hooper stated that the DMVS legal staff had advised DMVS that there was no provision for "grandfathering." Mr. Lindsey stated that he had consulted with the Attorney General representative for the Board, and he concurred with the DMVS position.
