

**Minutes Of The Used Motor Vehicle Parts Dealers Division  
December 8, 2005**

The Used Parts Division of the State Board of Registration of Used Motor Vehicle and Used Motor Vehicle Parts Dealers held its regular meeting on December 8, 2005, at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia. Robert Griggers, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 10 AM.

A quorum was established with the following board members present being: Robert Griggers, Chairman; Sidney McLeod, Cognizant Board Member; Kenneth Cronan, Board Member; Doug Hooper, Board Member; Steve Sumner, Board Member; John Palmer, Board member; and Gene Sapp, Board Member.

Devony Sanford with the IT Section and Steve Lindsey presented computer technology updates to the Board. Updates include an alternate website address for accessing information from the Professional Licensing Boards Division, [galicensing.org](http://galicensing.org). Applicants can now check the status of their pending applications, receive e-mail acknowledgement that an application has been received, and receive e-mail that a license has been issued. Docketed disciplinary orders are now scanned and made available online. The Professional Licensing Boards Division has changed the method of notifying licensees of the expiration of their licenses and the process of renewing their licenses. Paper renewal applications will no longer be mailed to each licensee. Licensees will now receive a postcard reminder of their license expiration date, and the reminder will include instructions for renewing the licenses online. Instructions will also include a telephone number to call to request a paper renewal form for those licensees who cannot or do not wish to renew online.
