**Review of letter from Tim Montgomery DVM/Discussion of renewal application questions.** – The Board also reviewed the letter from the GVMA. Mr. Scott Piper, Dr. Kevin Chapman and Dr. Spencer Tally, representatives from the GVMA addressed the Board.

**Approval of minutes as amended from the November 19, 2010 Conference Call Board meeting.** - Dr. Malphus made a motion to approve the November 19th Board minutes as amended. Mr. Lance seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**Rule Variance Request from Raymond Mason, DVM.** – Dr. Hill made a motion to approve allowing Dr. Mason until the end of the late renewal period and to acquire the required 10 hours of CE for renewal. The Board was provided with a copy of a letter of support from State Senator Jack Hill and State Representative Burch Parrish. Mr. Lance seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**Executive Director’s Open Session** – Ms. Anita Martin

- Ms. Martin stated that out of 3428 licensees, 1419 have renewed and 2009 have not yet renewed.
