UNIFORM ACT IMPLEMENTATION ORDER 2009-09

**ORDER ESTABLISHING FILING FEES FOR SECURITIES REGISTRATION
1973 Act References: O.C.G.A. § 10-5-6(a); O.C.G.A. § 10-5-9(5)**

The Commissioner of Securities for the State of Georgia (the "Commissioner") has determined that:

- (1) On July 1, 2009, the Georgia Securities Act of 1973 (the "1973 Act") was repealed by act of the Georgia General Assembly and that the Georgia Uniform Securities Act of 2008 (the "2008 Act") became effective on this same date.
- (2) Establishing a filing fee for securities registration is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes of the 2008 Act.
- (3) Pursuant to Sections 10-5-24 and 10-5-74(a) of the 2008 Act, the Commissioner has the authority to establish a filing fee for securities registration in Georgia.


In accordance with the above, the Commissioner hereby ORDERS that a person filing a registration statement under Section 10-5-23 of the 2008 Act shall pay an initial filing fee of one-twentieth of 1 percent of the maximum aggregate offering price at which the registered securities are to be offered in Georgia and a fee of \$100 for renewal. The initial fee shall not be less than \$250.

The Commissioner further ORDERS that a person filing a registration statement under Section 10-5-22 of the 2008 Act shall pay an initial filing fee of \$250 and a fee of \$100 for renewal.

This Order shall be effective as of July 1, 2009, and shall remain effective until modified or vacated, or superseded by Rule.
