ORDER TO DENY REGISTRATION APPLICATION

FINDINGS OF FACT

1.

On or about March 22, 2010, Jason E. Turonek applied for registration as a solicitor agent under O.C.G.A. §43-17-3.1. Turonek disclosed on the registration application the presence of a larceny conviction. The criminal background check conducted revealed that Turonek pled guilty to misdemeanor larceny on October 6, 2008.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The presence of the misdemeanor conviction is grounds for denial under O.C.G.A. §43-17-7(a)(4).

PUBLIC INTEREST

The Secretary of State has determined that it is in the public interest that such application be denied.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jason E. Turonek's Application for Registration as a solicitor agent is **DENIED**.
