David Jones called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. c43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to review information on applications and investigate reports. Voting in favor of the motion were Winston Strickland, Virgil Ergle, and Lutha Crump, and Lorena Barrios.

The board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue public session.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the petitions to waive the application fees of the following:
DAP/endorsementKatrina, AT/endorsementKatrina, MG/endorsementKatrina, DF/endorsementKatrina.

The Board instructed that Anthony Cabble conduct a preliminary inspection of PW/school on October 19, 2005 and Winston Strickland and Virgil Ergle conduct a final inspection on November 1, 2005.

The Assistant State Attorney General discussed the Board's plan to introduce proposed legislation regarding additional apprentices in Barber Shops/Salons and educational requirements for Barbers in Georgia.

The Board informed Ms. Jackson that the proposed legislation should include the following:

1. Raise the educational requirement from completion of the 7th grade to High School Diploma, GED certificate, or secondary education.
2. Provision that a Barber Shop/Salon may have more than one barber apprentice training in the shop/salon at one time under qualified licensed master barbers.

There was no further business conducted. The meeting was adjourned.
