Written Appeal:

Charles E. Redmon: The Board reviewed correspondence requesting the lifting of suspension of his license. Ms. Puckett made a motion to disapprove the request. Mr. Mehserle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence, Items of Information, and Written Requests:

Henry Howard Smith: The Board reviewed correspondence from the licensee, who had been granted an extension to complete his professional development requirements. After reviewing the documentation of completion, the Board approved the renewal for the 2005-2007 period.

Convictions: The Board reviewed documents relating to applications for renewal from five (5) licensees who answered “yes” to the conviction/sanction question. Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the recommendations of the Board. Mr. Mehserle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (See Attachment #1.)

Disciplinary Actions: The Board reviewed documents relating to applications for renewal from twenty-two (22) licensees who answered “yes” to the question on whether any disciplinary action had been taken against them by any state board or any other regulatory board. Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the recommendations of the Board. Mr. Mehserle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (See Attachment #1.)

Waiver of Professional Development Requirements Based on Professional Development Units (PDU) Earned In Other Jurisdictions: The Board reviewed correspondence from ten (10) licensees requesting waiver of professional development requirements for the 2005 renewal

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based on professional development units earned in another jurisdiction. After review of the supporting documentation, Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the recommendations of the Board. Mr. Mehserle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (Attachment #1.)

Extension of Professional Development Units (PDU): The Board reviewed correspondence from twenty-one (21) licensees requesting an extension to complete professional development requirements for the 2005 renewal period. Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the recommendations of the Board, and that the units completed during the 2005 renewal period cannot be used for the 2007 renewal. Mr. Mehserle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (See Attachment #1.)

Waiver of Professional Development Units (PDU): The Board reviewed correspondence from twelve (12) licensees requesting waiver of professional development requirements for the 2005 renewal period. Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the recommendations of the Board. Mr. Mehserle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (See Attachment #1.)

The Board reviewed the following orders from other states:

The Board considered an unsigned Cease and Desist Order from the Alabama State Board for Registration of Architects against a Georgia licensee that required no action at this time.

The Board considered a Final Order from the State of Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design relative to the 2003 renewal of a Georgia licensee. Ms. Love-Stanley made a motion to **disapprove** his renewal and to flag the file if the licensee applies for reinstatement in the future. Mr. Bolton seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board considered a Final Order from the Tennessee State Board of Architectural and Engineering Examiners against a Georgia licensee whose current status is lapsed. Ms. Love-Stanley made a motion to flag the file if the licensee applies for reinstatement in the future. Mr. Bolton seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Investigative Report:

The Board heard a report from the Investigative Unit and the Enforcement Committee on the following enforcement cases:

- **ARCH040012:** Mr. Mehserle made a motion to close the case and open a supplemental case to investigate the involvement of the associated architect. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **ARCH050053:** Mr. Mehserle made a motion to close the case and flag the file if the licensee applies for reinstatement. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

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- **ARCH050061:** Mr. Mehserle made a motion to close the case. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously
- **Greg H. Adams – Century Concepts:** Mr. Mehserle made a motion to accept a signed Voluntary Cease and Desist Order and to close the case. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **Santiago Iturralde:** Mr. Mehserle made a motion to accept a signed Voluntary Cease and Desist Order and to close the cases. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **Steve Kim:** Mr. Mehserle made a motion to accept a signed Voluntary Cease and Desist Order and to close the case. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board heard a report from the following staff members:

The Executive Director updated the Board on the following items:

Rules and Policies:

The Board reviewed a draft revision of Board Rule Chapter 50-3. The Committee will continue revising the draft for future Board review and approval.

The Board reviewed the general rules of the Professional Licensing Boards Division Director, Rule Chapter 295-15, regarding inactive status licensees.

Correspondence, Inquiries, and Items of Information:

The Board discussed self-reported continuing education. Mr. Bolton will obtain more information on the matter.

The Board reviewed correspondence regarding usage of the terms “Intern Architect” and “Architectural Intern”. The terms are acceptable to use as long as no implication of being licensed is given.

The Board reviewed a letter from Jeffrey A. Huberman of the NCARB Southern Conference.

The Board reviewed the March, 2005 minutes from the NCIDQ Board of Directors meeting.

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The Board reviewed correspondence and requests that did not require vote or action.

NCIDQ:

Ms. Puckett will represent the Board at the 2005 Annual Council of Delegates meeting in Denver, Colorado.

Election of Officers:

Ms. Love-Stanley made a motion to re-elect Anne K. Smith for President and E. Camille Puckett for Vice-President for the upcoming year. Mr. Bolton seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Propose To Post Rule 50-4-.01:

At its meeting on August 12, 2005, the Architects and Interior Designers Board voted to post 50-4-.01. The Board discussed revisions to its rules and considered modifications to Rule 50-4-.01. Ms. Smith made a motion to propose amendment of these rules and to post and hold a public hearing to receive comments regarding the proposed rules and to consider adoption of the rules following the public hearing. In its consideration of the proposed rules, the Board stated that the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose additional regulatory cost on any licensee that cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the statutes that are the basis for the proposed rules. Further, the Board stated that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of these statutes to adopt or implement differing actions for business as listed in O.C.G.A. Section 50-13-4(a)(3)(A)(B)(C) and (D) and that the formulation and adoption of these rules will impact every licensee in the same manner and each licensee is independently licensed, owned, and operated and dominant in the field of Architects and Interior Designers. Ms. Puckett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Other Business:

Michael W. Breedlove, Chairman of the Georgia State Board of Landscape Architects, gave a presentation to the Board on HB285, Georgia's Mandatory Education Certification Program for Erosion and Sedimentation Control. The Architects and Interior Designers' website will be updated to include a direct link to information regarding the certification program.

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned at 4:55 p.m.
