The hours must be completed within 1 year of the docketing of the Order and must be completed in person. Hours may not be applied to future Renewals. Issue a separate letter directing Respondent to update their advertising to reflect the use of the Respondent's legal name and to provide the Board documentation Supporting that the changes have been completed.
