Schedule an Investigative Interview.

CHIR180023

Table pending receipt of notification that respondent has completed criminal probation. If probation has been terminated, close the case with a Letter of Concern regarding the arrest.

CHIR180024

Close the case.

CHIR180025

Close the case.

CHIR180026


Obtain additional information as discussed and schedule an Investigative Interview.

CHIR180031

Table pending receipt of additional information concerning the arrest and actions in this case.
