The Georgia State Board of Barbers met on May 10, 2010 at the Professional Licensing Boards, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, GA 31217.

Chairperson, David Jones established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

David Jones presented a plaque to outgoing Board member, Lutha Crump, and thanked Mr. Crump for his years of dedicated service to the Barber Board.

The Board welcomed Richard Mullis to the Board.

Tom Wellman, Director of Correctional Programs with Middle Georgia Technical College described their vocational reentry program for the Georgia Department of Corrections. He reported a significant reduction in recidivism based on the vocational programs. He talked with the Board about the barbering aspect of the program.

David Jones turned the chair over to Lisa Durden, Executive Director.

A motion was made by Virgil Ertle, seconded by David Jones and the Board voted unanimously to accept the March 8, 2010 minutes.

Executive Director's report

Lisa Durden, Executive Director, gave the following reports:

- The Board was advised that Senate Bill #195 has been presented to the Governor for consideration. The Bill, if approved, will allow more than one apprentice per shop and will require apprentices to be a minimum of sixteen years of age.
- The DOAS General Liability policy was made available to Board members.
- Ms. Durden explained that Board members need to be set up for direct deposit for their per diem and mileage if they have not already done so.
- The February 2010 DL Roope Exam results were discussed. David Jones stated that he attended a recent examination and felt the process is going well.
