Discuss Rules

Roland Weekley, Chairman, informed the Division of the passing of SB214 which was amended to change the powers and duties of the Division of Electrical Contractors as to the approval of continuing education courses, and to prohibit certain advertisements related to electrical contracting. He discussed the need for the Division to review the board rule related to continuing education. Weekley also discussed the need for the Board to review Board Rule 121-2-.01 and Board Rule 121-3-.01 for possible revisions.

The Board was in agreement for Weekley and Hayes to be a subcommittee to review suggestions for possible rule revisions. Weekley will speak with each Division chairmen of the State Construction Industry Licensing Board to see if the other Divisions have rules which they may want to consider revising.

Executive Director Report:

The Executive Director, Deborah Beard informed the Board of the board processing numbers. Applications are being processed within seven business days. The current active license numbers are as follows: eight hundred and thirty-four (834) Electrical Restricted licenses and eight thousand and one hundred and sixty-seven (8,167) Electrical Non-Restricted licenses. The next testing window is scheduled for November 4-16, 2019.

Beard introduced the new Licensure Analyst, Tonya Davis who will assist with processing electrical contractor applications. Beard also informed the Board of the request for all Board Members to park in the back upper parking lot. This will ensure the front parking is available for visitors.
