Executive Director Report:

The Executive Director, Deborah Beard informed the Board of the board processing numbers. She informed the Board applications are currently being processed within seven (7) business days of receipt in the board office. The number of active licenses as of January 8, 2020: eight hundred and forty-eight (848) Electrical Contractor - Restricted licenses and eight thousand three hundred and forty-four (8,344) Electrical Non-Restricted licenses.

Beard asked the Division if they would like for staff to only present applications which meet the application deadline as posted on the website. The Board prefers to adhere to the deadline; however, any application staff reviews and is complete may be presented to the Board for review.

The Board was informed TiAndria Burke, Board Support Specialist, will be leaving to pursue other endeavors. She informed the Board of her future plans and when her last day would be with the department. The Board expressed their appreciation of her time with the Board and wished her well in her future endeavors.

Executive Session:

At 9:32 a.m. a motion was made by Weekley, seconded by Hayes, and the Division members present voted unanimously to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k), 43-1-19(h), and 50-14-2(1) to conduct applicant appearances. None opposed, motion carried.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Wednesday, January 8, 2020, Weekley declared the meeting to be “open” at 10:22 a.m. pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

Applicant Appearance:

The meeting was opened to conducted the appearance with Jack Ahmed in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 43-1-19. There was a brief discuss regarding the disciplinary action taken by the Board and his request to reinstate license with the Board. He explained the reason he wasn't at the continuation hearing held at OSAH. He explained his responses on the renewals which resulted in disciplinary action taken by the Board. He provided an update as to what work he has performed since the revocation of his license. He informed the Division he has taken the position as salesman for his company. He reported Raymond Jones worked as his licensed qualifier for one year from 2018 to 2019. He changed qualifiers in September 2019. Scott Carter is his current qualifier and is employed as a contractor. Mr. Carter pulls the permits, handles estimating and supervises jobs. The Board discussed some concerns regarding information filed with the Board. He explained he hasn't pulled permits during the time he has not held a license. He has sent workers to

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provide service work in some cases. He further explained some contracts in which he was aware there may have been some concerns.

None opposed, motion carried.
