Appeal of Decision from Mike Douglas from April 17, 2021. After hearing the facts of the appeal from the Executive Director, Commissioner Traub makes a motion to deny. Vice Chairman Thompson seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0 to deny. Commissioner Traub ask we handle the official internally.

Appeal of Decision from Rashad Scott from April 18, 2021. After hearing testimony from Rashad Scott, Commissioner Traub makes a motion to deny the appeal without video evidence to show he has inappropriate equipment. Vice Chairman Thompson seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0 to deny.

Proposed Rule Change – Rule 85-1-.05 Conduct of Promotion. Commissioner Traub makes a motion to approve and send to the Attorney General’s office for legal authority. Commissioner Orlans seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0 to approve.

Proposed Rule Change- Rule 85-4-.07 Contestants’ Equipment. Commissioner Traub makes a motion to approve and send to the Attorney General’s office for legal authority. Commissioner Orlans seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0 to approve.

Proposed Rule Change- Rule 85-2-.03 Rounds. Commissioner Traub makes a motion to approve and send to the Attorney General’s office for legal authority. Chairman Millican seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0 to approve.

Commissioner Traub leaves the meeting.

Discussion on Venue Security. Chairman Millican makes a motion to create an effective immediately policy change to require 1 security guard for everyone 100 persons in a venue. Vice Chairman Thompson seconds, and the Commission votes 4-0 to approve. Chairman Millican ask for this to be worked up as an official rule change as well.

Discussion on policy regarding license fee. Matt Woodruff informs the Commission that the Secretary of State’s office is currently reviewing systems and will hopefully get online license available soon.

Discussion on Fighter Meetings arrival time. Mr. Woodruff informs the Commission of proposed fighter meeting ideas and is willing to review this rule if the Commission wants to further review.

Discussion on Reopening Plan. Chairman Millican tables this until June where the Commission will look to modify the current plan or remove it completely.

Vice Chairman Thompson leaves the meeting.
