Follow Up on Appeal of Decision by Terri Moss from September 16, 2021. Chairman Millican makes a motion to deny. Commissioner Traub seconds, and the Commission votes 3-0 to deny.

Follow Up Discussion on Dalton Bodie break of contract from August 21, 2021. Chairman Millican makes a motion to table to look further into a few items around this case. Commissioner Traub seconds, and the Commission votes 3-0 to table to December.

Follow Up Discussion with Montreal James from September 25, 2021. After hearing from Chris Scott, Chairman Millican makes a motion to table to allow for a possible settlement to be reached. A final decision will be made in December. Commissioner Reynolds seconds, and the Commission votes 3-0 to table.

Review of Kijuan Edwards suspension from July 24th no show. Chairman Millican makes a motion to lift the suspension. Commissioner Traub seconds, and the Commission votes 3-0 to lift.
