Cleghorn provided information regarding the number of applications and complaints received and the number of licenses issued.

Cleghorn confirmed that no applications for licensure had been denied and noted that there were currently 149 active licensees. It was reported that there were 160 active licenses in May 2019.

**ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE**

Tracy provided information regarding the matter of Jackson v. Raffensperger. The case challenging the constitutionality of the law advanced to the Supreme Court of Georgia where it was remanded back to the Superior Court of Fulton County.

Aldridge recommended that the Advisory Group designate Merrilee Gober as the liaison between the Group and the Attorney General's Office for the case.

Tracy provided information noting that the enforcement provisions of the statute continue to be stayed pending the resolution of all appeals.
