#### Executive Director's Report

The Executive Director, Deborah Beard, informed the Division of the two new consumer board members, Mitch McEven and Mark Herbert who were appointed to the State Construction Industry Licensing Board.

Beard also informed the Board of the number of licenses for the Division of Low Voltage Contractors as of July 09, 2019. There were 582 Low Voltage - General, 573 Low Voltage - Telecommunication, 1,102 Low Voltage - Alarm and 1,959 Low Voltage - Unrestricted which comes to a total of 4,216 licensees.
