OPEN SESSION

The Committee discussed the following matters:


- Comments and recommendations from the Advisory Committee meeting, which took place on August 20, 2020.
- Allowing anyone who holds an active, unencumbered Georgia license as a Nursing Home Administrator to obtain licensure as a Personal Care Home Administrator or Assisted Living Community Administrator without having to meet any testing and training requirements in addition to what is required to obtain a license as a Nursing Home Administrator.
- Allowing an individual that holds more than one license issued by this Board to complete the highest number of continuing education hours which are required to renew any one license, instead of a combination of hours.
- Changing language in current rules regarding requirement that half of all required CE hours be completed in-person, to allow that courses taught via a live webinar that is instructor led with student interaction, where student participation is monitored and verified, counts the same as an in-person course.
- Content areas required for continuing education.

There being no further business, Barbara Baxter, Acting Chair, declared the meeting adjourned at 11:03 a.m.
