Call to Order:

At 9:07 a.m., Board Chair Smith established a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

Request to Address Board

Kevin Coleman addressed the Board regarding his concerns of unlicensed practice. He discussed his concerns of individuals selling their licenses to unlicensed individuals and to companies. There was discussion as to what action the Board could take against unlicensed individuals and those who may be selling their license to unlicensed persons/companies. The Board discussed the complaint process and stated if a complaint were filed it is most beneficial to have as much information as possible including the individuals name, address, company name/address, and name of the licensee. There was discussion of the cease and desist process, as well.

Hearing:

At 10:10 a.m. the Board conducted a hearing related to disciplinary action against the respondent Ronald Wayne Divin, license number MP207882. The court reporter holds the transcripts, exhibits, and all other related documents presented at the hearing.

Executive Session:

At 11:15 a.m. a motion was made by Smith, seconded by Maushardt, and the Board members present voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k), 43-1-19(h), and 50-14-2(1). None opposed, motion carried.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session on Wednesday, September 27, 2017, Smith declared the meeting to be “open” pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

Open Session:

Hearing:

A motion was made by Smith, seconded by McCravy, and the Board voted to issue a final decision for respondent’s license as a master plumber (MP207882) to be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years subject to terms and conditions of the master plumber license. In summary, the conditions include the respondent’s master plumber license being restricted to commercial plumbing. Respondent shall not perform any residential plumbing during the probationary period. Violations of this term and conditions shall be grounds for summary suspension of license and other disciplinary action. Respondent shall provide is current and any future employers with a copy of the Final Decision during the probationary period. Respondent shall comply with all laws and rules relating to the practice of plumbing. After Respondent’s license has been on probation for a five (5) years, Respondent may petition the Division for termination of probation by certifying in writing under oath that he has complied with all conditions of probation set forth in the Final Decision. Failure to petition for terminating probation shall result in the probationary status continuing notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Final Decision. Upon request to terminate probation, the Division may review all relevant information and may require Respondent to meet with the Division or a representative thereof. Lifting of the probation shall be within the discretion of the Division, and shall not be considered a contested case. Probation remains in effect until lifted in writing by the Division.

Executive Director’s Report:

Deborah Beard, Executive Director, updated the Board on the SOS plan to move forward with the new Sharepoint system for board meetings. Discussed exam registration deadlines and the importance of Cognizant’s review of applications and complaints prior to board meetings.

Deborah Beard also presented the Board with the 2015 and 2016 examination results. A motion was made by McCravy, seconded by Cunningham, and the Board voted to post the 2015 and 2016 examination results to the Board website.
