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HB 364

The Board reviewed House Bill 364, which proposes to amend the Board's statute to remove the requirement for fingerprint based federal background checks for anyone that is P.O.S.T. certified. Tripp Mitchell motioned that the Board go on record as having concerns with this bill, exempting individuals who are not law enforcement officers and are no longer employed in the position that required them to be P.O.S.T. certified but have still maintained their P.O.S.T. certification, which would potentially require the Board to issue licenses or registrations with a permit to carry a weapon to individuals who have not completed a federal background check. Tim Smith seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Rules Review

The Board conducted a rules review, making changes to the proposed rule amendments that were recommended by the Attorney General's office. At the conclusion of the rules review Tripp Mitchell motioned, Tim Smith seconded and the Board voted to refer the proposed rule amendments back to the Attorney General's office for an updated Memorandum of Authority.

Executive Director's Report

The Board reviewed the Executive Director's report which provided statistical data regarding licensing and complaints.

There being no further business, Tim Williams, Chair, declared the meeting adjourned at 11:10 a.m.


