The Board considered the change of location request from Rebecca Harrison Rebuilder. It was the Board's decision that Ms Harrison must provide the Board with a completed zoning certification and photographs showing the permanent sign in the exact same name of the business must be visible from the street.

Mr. McLeod informed board members that the exam committee is providing a work log of the day to day activities of the rebuilding, auctioning, and recycling business to the Exam Section. Mr. Griggers stated that the exam will be graded on a point system.

The Board asked that Mr. Lindsey send a letter to the corporate headquarters of a second auto parts franchise advertising “used parts for sale” and inform them of Georgia’s used motor vehicle parts dealers licensure requirements.
