Executive Director's Report:

Deborah Beard, the Executive Director informed the Board Members provided the Board with an update on the number of complaints and applications processed since the start of the fiscal year of July 1, 2018, and the number of current licensee's for each license type. The current number of licenses are as follows: 1,364 Utility Managers, 1,061 Utility Foreman, and 994 Utility Contractors. There has been a total of 202 applications processed since July 1, 2018.

2711055 J.D. – Applicant may submit proof of completion of confined spaces and competent persons training and documentation of work in the field supervising the installation of utility systems for a minimum of two years. Also submit proof and documentation employer had a utility manager for timeframe employed.
