VET190015	Close the case as the standard of care has been met.
VET190017	Close case for respondent D.L.E. and initiate a new case on respondent D.L.D.
VET190018	Close the case, no action.
VET190021	Schedule an Investigative Interview.
VET190020	Refer to the Attorney General's Office for legal advice regarding O.C.G.A. § 43-50-43(4) as it relates to the procedure for canceling a license.
VET190025	Close the case with a Letter of Concern regarding prescribing practices.
VET190026	Schedule an Investigative Interview.
