On behalf of the Georgia Hospital Association (GHA) and its nearly 160 hospital members, we appreciate the opportunity to submit comments in support of the Georgia Board of Nursing's (the "Board's") proposed amendments to Rule 410-8, which governs registered nursing (RN) education programs (the "Proposed Rules").

We appreciate the Board's efforts to help increase the number of qualified graduates from Georgia's nursing schools and believe the Proposed Rules are a positive step towards addressing Georgia's health care workforce shortage.

Removing barriers to the operation of an RN education program can help address this statewide issue. We therefore respectfully request that the Board consider further revising Rule 410-8.05(06) to remove the requirement that the majority of all faculty members in an RN education program need to be full-time rather than just removing the requirement that the majority of clinical faculty members need to be full-time, as set forth in the Proposed Rules.

I would like to formally express my objection to the proposed amendment for clinical Instructor to student ratios. Increasing the number of students to (10) does nothing to improve the quality of clinical education being provided to nursing students in Georgia. I lead the division of Nursing for two acute care hospitals (one being a trauma center) in the city of Columbus and am seeing a measurable decline in the quality of graduates. I interface with graduate nurses who display diminished clinical competency, along with the inability to manage the professional demands of a Registered Nurse role. By agreeing to compromise these ratios, the Board is agreeing to compromise nursing education (in my opinion).

1. Not diagnosed the nurse with a substance use disorder (SUD); yet is making monitoring recommendations that the Board is unable to impose without a SUD diagnosis. (i.e., drug testing x 1 year, abstinence from substances)
2. Has not diagnosed the nurse with a substance use disorder (SUD), yet is making monitoring recommendations to rule out a SUD
3. Diagnoses the nurse with a substance use disorder and makes monitoring recommendations that are inconsistent with the Board’s usual monitoring terms and conditions (i.e., length of monitoring, narcotic restrictions x 1yr, work restrictions-no more than 40-hour work weeks, etc.). These recommendations vary depending on the evaluator several options for GBON Board to consider assisting Providers in giving accurate information back to the Board from Board requested MPE.

Tara researched with other Nursing Boards in the criteria that is used with MPE and what they are requesting from the Providers. Several options were presented for the Board’s consideration. After discussion, it was determined that the Board is requesting a combination of options that would include, specific guidelines and criteria for all MPE providers to follow and a checklist.

Tara will work on compiling a Criteria / Checklist that the Board will consider for our providers.

Education – 04 – Berry College - Change of Leadership

Berry College (EDUCATION 04)

February 14, 22 Dr. Alan Hughes, Interim Dean of the Charter School of Education and Health Sciences notified the board that they had hired a new Director of Nursing. UNG has proposed the addition of an Accelerated BSN (ABSN) program. The same BSN curriculum will be utilized for the ABSN program as for the traditional BSN program. A sample plan of study (four semesters) can be found on page 5 of the board packet that was submitted by UNG. One cohort will be admitted per year in January and graduate the next May. The same admission requirements will be utilized with the exception that the applicant must hold either a baccalaureate degree or master's degree in another field. This program will be offered on the Gainesville UNG campus where 35,000 square feet has been dedicated for the ABSN nursing program. This includes two 100 seat classrooms, an eight bay Sim Center, and two skills lab which can accommodate 20 students in each. UNG has collaborated with Northeast Georgia Health System for funding and clinical placement (see board packet for legal agreement and letter of support). UNG has over 30 years of experience in nursing education programs with good board scores.

I recommend acceptance of this administrative change notification.

Education – 20– Augusta Technical College – Change in Leadership

Augusta Technical College (EDUCATION 09)

On February 16, 2022, the board was notified of the appointment of Dr. Ebony Story, DNP, MSN, RN to the Department head for the College's Associate Degree Program with a start date of February 14, 2022. The current Department Chair has submitted his notice to retire in a few months. We believe that this appointment will allow a seamless transition. Dr. Story has served as the Department head for the College's Practical Nursing Program for four years.

She has taught for four years, including 18 months in the ADN program at Lanier Technical College.

According to Board Rule 409-9-.07(2)(a) Qualifications for Employment, the Nursing Program Administrator hold a current Georgia license in good standing from the initial date of employment as a registered professional nurse and (b) the director of a nursing education program shall have at least a baccalaureate degree in nursing and one (1) year of teaching experience in a nursing education program, (included in the required three (3) years of nursing practice). Education – 21 License 2838346

2838346 (EDUCATION 21)

As requested by CFGNS and the GBON the international applicant #2838346 completed 30 clinical hours in both OB and Pediatrics and 15 hours of didactic in both OB and Pediatrics. This was substantiated by the Dean of Nursing at Reinhardt University and letters from both faculty (including clinical faculty) outlining the content of the didactic and clinical. According to RN board rule 410-8-.03(3) At any point during the initial approval period for developing programs or within the four-year approval cycle for established programs, the Board may impose Conditional Approval on a nursing education program for reasons, including but not limited to, the following conditions: review of any annual report reveals noncompliance with the rules; review(s) of the most recent site visit report(s) and program response(s) to it reveal continued, documented noncompliance with the rules; and/or the passing percentage of first-time writers on the licensing examination was less than eighty (80) percent for two (2) consecutive graduation cohorts and/or the four-year average was less than eighty (80) percent.

Program Approval

Education – 09A Georgia Southwestern University – Initial Approval

Georgia Southwestern University (EDUCATION 09A)

Georgia Southwestern University (GSW) has requested that the board review and grant initial approval of GSW's Associate Degree Program in Nursing. Their intent is to enroll students in pre-nursing classes fall 2022. Students would then be accepted to the nursing program spring 2023 and enroll in nursing courses summer 2023. GSW will admit one cohort each year to start.

GSW has included:

- (A) Official notification of level approval change, effective December 2, 2021, has been received from SACSCOC. This letter is included as an attachment in the Board packet.
- (B) The ASN Student Handbook has been developed and is included.
- (C) Confirmation that the appropriate personnel will be hired to offer this program. We have two active searches underway for two full time faculty and are currently receiving/reviewing applications. The director will be hired June 1, 2022. The second faculty member will begin August 1, 2022. A full-time administrative support staff member will be hired July 1, 2022
- (D) Site visit was February 24, 2022.

The documents in the Board Packet from July 2021 and March 2022 provide the supporting credentials needed to satisfy GBON rule 410-8-.12 (1)-(4)

Georgia Southwestern University has a longstanding history of graduating good nurses since 1953--69 years. GSW began with an ASN program which they terminated in 2001 (48 years) to start a BSN program. The underpinning has been established.

Georgia Southwestern University respectfully requests initial approval.

As outlined in Board Rule 410-8-.12 All documentation has been submitted to the Board. According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(1)(b) The Board may grant Initial Approval to a nursing education program with Developmental Approval when compliance with Rule 410-8-.12(4) has been documented. Initial Approval is required prior to the enrollment of at least twenty (20) students in the first nursing courses. (See documentation in the Board Packet on the Bridge)

I recommend granting Georgia Southwestern University Initial Approval of their new ASN program.

Education – 17 Fort Valley State University – Developmental Approval

Fort Valley State University (EDUCATION 17)

Fort Valley State University (FVSU) is asking the board for developmental approval for a BSN program. The nursing program will prepare a diverse population of competent and caring nurses by providing a rigorous academic program to reduce health disparities. program will integrate quality instruction with student learning experiences that are responsive to the needs of both a culturally and economically diverse student population, and the provision of care to serve economically diverse rural families and communities. The university has a rich history of quality science programs that have produced physicians, pharmacists, dentists, and veterinarians, many of whom are continuing to work and practice within rural communities. January 1, 2022, FVSU hired a nursing administrator, Dr. Lawanda Greene, DNP, MSN, MPH, APRN, AGACNP-BC. Dr. Greene previously taught at Middle Georgia State University for nine years and has been the MSN Coordinator for the last five years. Dr. Greene brings a depth and breadth of knowledge and experience to this position. (See Prospectus in the Board Packet on the Bridge)

Board Rule 410-8-.02 addresses Nursing Education Program Approval. 410-8-02(1) addresses developing programs – (1)(a) states: The Board may grant Developmental Approval to a proposed nursing education program when compliance with Rules 410-8-.12 paragraphs (1) through (3) has been documented.

I recommend that the Board approve For Valley State University's application for development approval.

Education – 09B Georgia Southwestern University – Site Visit

Georgia Southwestern University (EDUCATION 09B)

Georgia Southwestern was visited on Thursday February 24, 2022. The administration, faculty and staff were very welcoming. I was there for six hours. I met with faculty and administration. I received a tour of the facilities and was very impressed by their state-of-the-art SIM center and storage!

Recommendations:

- Apply for initial approval for the ASN program at the March board meeting.
- Continue with the hiring process for one more ASN faculty member (there is one faculty member moving from the pre-licensure BSN program into the ASN program who will have three-unit release time for coordinating).
- Begin to advertise for the new cohort who will begin Summer 2023 in the nursing program and Fall 2022 for pre-requisites.

I ask the board to approve my report and recommendations.

Education – 08G– Georgia Northwestern Technical College – Site Visit

Georgia Northwestern Technical College ASN and PN (EDUCATION 08G)

Georgia Northwestern Technical College was visited on Monday February 28, 2022. The administration, faculty, and staff were very welcoming.

Recommendations:

- Replace open position for SIM/Skills Coordinator – This job is posted
- Hire New Nursing Administrator (have had three in the last year)
- Lockdown browser for school computers to help prevent dishonesty
- Access additional computer labs so that testing does not have to be staggered that can compromise the exam and outcomes
- Set up a pool of adjuncts with specialty background to help with clinicals
- Establish a procedure for reentry students and remediation
- As per board rules, administrator must have time allotted for administration duties. Nursing administrator carries a full course load. As discussed, compensation should be offered.

Med-Life Lauderdale Lakes (CORRESPONDENCE)

- Transcript for Board to Review – Student missing OB clinical practicum

I spoke with the Director of the Nurse Education Consultants for the state of Florida, Dr. Sherri Sutton-Johnson, DPh., MSNEd, RN. Med Life had two ASN programs at the Lauderdale Lakes location at 4000 North State Road #7. One had the NCLEX code 70719 which was terminated 11/22/2017 and began 2/16/2012. There was a three year teach out program where students would be eligible to graduate from an approved nursing program. The program then closed. If students had to retake boards after that time period (the three additional years) they would be keyed as a closed school. The second Med Life NCLEX code was 70739 which opened 7/23/2012 and was terminated 10/17/2017. Same teach out as above. So, students who were enrolled during the time the schools were open were approved by the FLBON and students who were enrolled prior to the termination are considered approved.

With this information from the Florida Board of Nursing, I recommend that the board approve endorsement by reciprocity for graduates fall within this timeframe after the Nurse Educator reviews transcripts.

There are two nurses who are willing to complete a preceptor rotation for our students at this time but have less than the 1 year required.

Corrective Action Plans 2021

Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College (ADN): EDUCATION 01

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern

- COVID-19 Impacts
- Remnants of consolidation
- Faculty/Staff turn-over
- Decline in HESI remediation/course performance
- Students delaying in registering for NCLEX-RN and testing.
- Closer monitoring of student performance on NCLEX-RN
- Upcoming changes to NCLEX-RN to Next Gen format

Plans for Improvement

- Returned to face-to-face instruction, including skills laboratory, simulation, and clinical rotations.
- Following consolidation between ABAC and Bainbridge State College, areas missing within the curriculum were identified. Thus, a medical-surgical course progression chart was developed to confirm all topics were covered. In addition, content was re-distributed throughout the medical surgical courses to ensure the progression of simple to complex, and ensure the content is commensurate in each course.
- Faculty/Staff turn-over has occurred frequently since consolidation occurred. Since 2017, 15 faculty/staff members have resigned between the two locations, including 2 Deans. We were fortunate to hire multiple new faculty members, replacing less experienced and lower performing faculty, who chose to leave.
- A HESI Specialty Exam is required at the completion of each of the nursing courses. The faculty approved a change to enforce remediation is completed prior to beginning the following semester.
- In the capstone course within the ASN program, NURS 2210/B, students are now being required to complete the registration process as a course requirement. In fact, a student's grades will not be released until registration has been completed with the Georgia Board of Nursing, NCSBN, and COGENT background check.
 - A subscription to Blue Mountain Measurements has been placed. Blue Mountain Measures provides reports on how students perform on the NCLEX-RN and helps identify areas needing further development.
 - To prepare for the NextGen changes and avoid an additional decline in board scores, faculty are transitioning to more active learning teaching strategies in the classroom.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(2)(b) A nursing education program, with Full Approval, must submit a written assessment and plan of action for review by the Board if the passing percentage of all first-time writers on the licensing examination is less than eighty (80) percent in a calendar year. (2021 NCLEX 78.38%). **I recommend acceptance of the report. See full report in board packet.**

Albany State University (ADN): EDUCATION 02

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

- A significant decline in pass rates in 2020 when the pandemic disproportionately impacted Albany, Georgia.
 - Students were without access to the internet and computer.
 - Many students experienced various hardships (hospitalizations, COVID, family/friends' death, loss of employment, homelessness, lack of childcare) that hindered their learning during 2020 and 2021, with a subsequent decline in board scores.
- During the pandemic, it was determined that students could not connect textbook reading with hands-on learning experiences from healthcare facilities. Support was offered that included securing students' resources and implementing curriculum changes.
- Some curriculum changes included:
 - An updated grading scale (Summer 2022),
 - Implemented standardized testing in each course (Spring 2022),
 - Revised unit objectives in Adult Health I & II (Spring 2022),
 - Imposing NCLEX predictor benchmarks (Spring 2022).
 - The placement of Pharmacology for Nursing is on schedule (Fall 2023) to be moved into the same semester with Adult Health I in hopes of helping students better connect illness with medication treatment regimens and increase end-of-course Pharmacology Standardized exam scores.
 - The 8-week standalone Capstone Comprehensive Nursing Review course will be added (Fall 2023) to provide an assessment and customized remediation of all nursing courses for students in their final semester of the program.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(3) programs are required to submit a corrective action plan and participate in a site visit based on NCLEX performance. Program is currently on conditional approval (4-year NCLEX 78.57%). **I recommend acceptance of the report and a site visit for Spring 2022. See full report in board packet.**

Andrew College (ADN): EDUCATION 03

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

- Areas of opportunity identified to improve NCLEX performance are Student Learning Support and Resources, NextGen Preparation, Exam Analysis, Review, and Blueprinting, Standardization of Faculty Expectations, Admission Criteria, Curriculum Plan, Faculty Development, and New Faculty Orientation. Implemented many changes with regards to each category and have planned changes for the upcoming Academic year.
- Hold faculty accountable to the new standards, secure resources, such as a nursing specific tutor to promote the success of students.
- The current curriculum plan was reviewed and presented and received approval for the new plan going into the 22-23 Academic year. The new plan will help achieve both enrollment goals as well as the NCLEX pass rate goal.
- The implementation of ATI has already been fruitful by way of the data piece alone. One example, on the first day of class the 05/22 cohort took a practice comprehensive predictor exam without any preparation. Seven of the 15 students scored high enough to have a 95% chance of passing NCLEX on the first attempt compared to 1 out of 13 in the most recent graduating cohort. The comparison between cohorts is valuable, and the predictive analytics of ATI are unmatched.
- Faculty have worked diligently blueprinting exams and attaching focused review resources in ATI so that students each have a tailored remediation rather than a general remediation assignment as was previously the practice.
- Exam blueprint roll-up data per cohort are reviewed at each faculty meeting so that exam writing becomes data driven in real time.
- We are encouraged by the 05/22 co-hort. Their test performance surpasses that of the most recently graduated cohort, and we have every reason to believe they will achieve an 80% pass rate.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(3) programs are required to submit a corrective action plan and participate in a site visit based on NCLEX performance. Program is currently on conditional approval (4-year NCLEX 41.85%). **I recommend acceptance of the report and a site visit for Spring 2022. See full report in board packet.**

Clayton State University (BSN): EDUCATION 05

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

- The campus physically closed mid-March 2020 and all classes were converted to an online format for one year.
 - All content was delivered via Microsoft TEAMS, lectures were recorded using Kaltura, and an online testing platform using Lockdown browser was implemented.
 - Our clinical partners closed their units to nursing students, thus, virtual simulation (VSims) was provided as opposed to actual, in hospital, clinical rotations
 - All classes returned to in person clinical during the fall 2021 semester.
- **Decrease in Course Preparation and Exam Scores**
 - **Students were not prepared for classroom discussions and had lower test scores with an exam breach while having online exams.**
 - A Faculty Success Team (FST) was initiated in Fall 2021. The (FST) met weekly with groups of students to discuss different clinical concepts and answer NCLEX style questions. Any student that scored less than an 80 on an exam, was referred to a member of the FST for a virtual meeting.
- **It was identified that several students were not meeting the benchmarks on the Standardized Kaplan Exams.**

- A new standardized testing policy was developed and included in each syllabus for all nursing courses. To be successful on the standardized exams, students are required to obtain a passing score designated for each course according to the specific course policy. Students who are unsuccessful on the initial attempt will be required to develop and complete a remediation plan. For the student to be scheduled to repeat a test, evidence of remediation should be emailed to the Standardized Testing Coordinator and the course coordinator. After completing the remediation, students will have the opportunity to re-test.
- **Developed a Student Success Self-Study Course**
 - In the event a student is not successful on the Kaplan exam and does not meet the required benchmark, they will be enrolled in a one hour mini-mester course (approximately seven weeks long) that will concentrate on test taking skills and the completion on NCLEX questions.
- **Provide an in house NCLEX Hurst Review**
 - Increase performance on the NCLEX exam.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(2)(b) A nursing education program, with Full Approval, must submit a written assessment and plan of action for review by the Board if the passing percentage of all first-time writers on the licensing examination is less than eighty (80) percent in a calendar year. (2021 NCLEX 78.38%). **I recommend acceptance of the report. See full report in board packet.**

Columbus State University (BSN): EDUCATION 06B

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

- 1) Student accountability needed to be addressed to ensure students were following expected policies including time and attendance and clinical requirements. This is part of students being able to meet expectations in general and improve student learning.
 - Plan - Faculty are addressing this with students to ensure that these policies are followed.
 - The students are placed on clinical probation or given a behavior disposition to implement a plan for improvement of these behaviors. Prelicensure faculty have been empowered and supported to address these policies in the most effective manner.
- 2) At-risk students are a portion of those who are not successful with NCLEX, and students needed to be identified early to ensure the best possible outcome.
 - Mentors have always been assigned but resources have been shared to improve this process for students.
 - i. These resources include information on barriers to learning and advice to give to students and the importance of record-keeping in determining continued difficulty with success.
 - A faculty tutor program has been implemented for referrals for students who are having difficulty with exams.
 - Another area to help at-risk students was developing an Academic Success Plan that could be tracked by the students, mentors, and the Interim Director, to ensure that students who had been unsuccessful with a course had needed resources for success.
- 3) The predictor exams for NCLEX success being changed to HESI. Faculty are able to track individual students and their strengths and weaknesses and also review most missed areas on the predictor specialty and comprehensive exams for curriculum revision.
 - Being able to add the Comprehensive Exam as a predictor of NCLEX success at the end of the program with a grade that would determine if students were ready to take NCLEX will also help with being sure that students have adequate preparation.
- 4) Student resources are an important part of student success.
 - Having the HESI case studies and practice exams to prepare for the HESI exams and reinforce learning in the classroom setting was a helpful addition.
 - Faculty members are an important resource for students outside the classroom with maintaining office hours and meeting with students to explain content taught.

- Faculty also have a consistently scheduled exam review prior to each exam
 - The faculty also are consistently providing exam debriefings on an individual and class basis to help with application of knowledge and test-taking strategies.
 - Having a PT faculty member who also tutors was an important addition for student success.
 - Students will benefit from having a peer mentoring program that will be implemented for academic year 2022-23.
 - The Senior level faculty have added resources that include an orientation for all rising seniors and a skills lab to help practice these prior to beginning clinicals in the Fall semester.
- 5) Faculty development needs were another area that needed to be addressed due to some faculty being inexperienced and not having the same level of interaction in previous years with the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Faculty have been provided with meetings and workshops as a group to address learning needs related to the structure of the School of Nursing and academia in general and faculty teaching and item-writing.
 - Faculty have been provided a teaching evaluation by a peer for self-improvement and have been encouraged to complete individual workshops through resources like Nurse Tim and AACN.
 - The faculty have been supported to attend conferences by a travel budget provided by the Dean of COEHP. There is a CNE drive, to encourage faculty certification in nursing education and this is supported by the Interim Director and the Dean of COEHP.
- 6) Admission Standards are a concern to ensure that students being admitted have the best possible chance of success.
- Most students who were unsuccessful on NCLEX were transfer students and a higher percentage had failed one science course.
 - It is important for mentors to be aware of these trends to define these students as at-risk for closer monitoring of their exam scores.
 - A trend in the scores on HESI A2 as a requirement for admission was analyzed as well and the recommendation has been made for the students to have a minimum of 75 on each of the three sections of the HESI A2.

Program is currently on conditional approval (4-year NCLEX 77.85%). **I recommend acceptance of the report and a site visit for Spring 2022. See full report in board packet.**

Georgia Northwestern Technical College (ADN): EDUCATION 08F

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. COVID-19 barriers impeding student instruction.
 - The students graduating in the 2021 class were the first students to experience the unprecedented effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - The students participated in virtual learning beginning in March 2020 and completed their entire mental health clinical rotations fully online.
 - These students also completed almost all lecture, unit exams, and Health Education Systems, Inc. (HESI) exams entirely online.
2. Faculty turnover and position changes.
 - When the 2021 class began in 2019, the last experienced faculty member resigned in October, 2019. The remaining three faculty members had all been instructing in the ASN program for less than two years. In 2019, two new faculty members were hired who had no experience instructing in a full time ASN program; the 2021 cohort had relatively inexperienced faculty training new faculty at that time.
 - Our former Executive Director announced her retirement in the fall of 2020. Her official retirement date was not until April 2021, however, one of the faculty began transitioning into the role of Nursing Administrator leaving a full-time faculty position vacant.

- The structure changes included the ASN program would have a director, a nursing administrator, and a dean; the previous Executive Director position encompassed all these roles. Since the spring of 2021, a new dean, not a nurse, was hired, the new nursing administrator resigned, an interim nursing administrator was named, a program director was appointed from within, and two new full-time nursing faculty were hired. Substantial transitions have occurred within the ASN program since 2019 causing emotional hardship and, at times, difficulty completing daily activities. Periods of uncertainty, ambiguity, and unsettlement have led to tasks being overlooked, unaddressed, or unfulfilled where, prior to the many vacancies and turnover, previous expert efficiency existed.
3. Full time Lab Coordinator vacancy.
 - Related to faculty turnover is the full-time lab coordinator position, which has not been filled longer than six months since the coordinator transitioned in 2019 as a full-time faculty member. The position was held until April of 2021.
 - The full-time lab coordinator position is a crucial component to the success of the ASN program. During the time the position was filled consistently, NCLEX-RN pass rates ranged between 79.17% and 91.30%.
 - Without this position, there is a breakdown in the supply chain regarding ordering and maintaining supplies. Equipment, including simulators, lack necessary maintenance along with deficiencies in the overall maintenance of the skills and simulation lab spaces.
 - With a full-time lab coordinator position on the Walker County Campus (WCC), the students complete clinical skills and simulations in a controlled environment. A lab coordinator is essential in preparing and exposing students to equipment and scenarios for which they may encounter in the clinical field. This role allows students to feel more confident in their abilities, which can lead to an increase in critical thinking and application of the nursing process.
 4. The need for review, revision, and improved implementation as well as follow through of the HESI specific remediation plan and re-entry student policy.
 - It has been noted that students who reenter have a harder time on the NCLEX.
 - i. Two of the six students who failed boards were reentry students.
 - ii. A re-entry student policy will be developed to assist those returning students.
 - There has been noted an inconsistency in the use of the HESI remediation plan across the curriculum.
 - i. A HESI champion has been identified within the faculty.
 - ii. A new HESI Remediation Policy should be finalized by faculty to begin the end of spring semester, 2022.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(2)(b) A nursing education program, with Full Approval, must submit a written assessment and plan of action for review by the Board if the passing percentage of all first-time writers on the licensing examination is less than eighty (80) percent in a calendar year. (2021 NCLEX 73.33%). **I recommend acceptance of the report. See full report in board packet.**

Gordon State (ADN): EDUCATION 10

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. Student qualifications
 - Institute a Math/Science GPA requirement for the ASN program.
 - Revise admission criteria to ensure that qualified students are admitted to the program, not just students that meet minimum criteria.
 - Require a letter of recommendation for admission applications that requires assessment of the applicant's work ethic/behaviors.
2. Faculty Turnover - Fill faculty and staff vacancies
 - Over the last three years faculty were lost due to various reasons including:
 - i. retirement,

- ii. new job opportunities
 - iii. illness and even death. As many as seven full time faculty were lost. These were experienced faculty. This could have caused some disorganization and/or adjustments in the way students were helped in the classroom
- 3. Faculty experience
 - o Assign mentors for new faculty and place a consistent faculty member in the 4th semester ASN program.
- 4. Department instability
 - o Become one Nursing Department in the School of Nursing, Health and Natural Sciences with one Dean.
- 5. AIM Program – The Academic Intervention and Mentoring (AIM) program was created to provide nursing students with academic intervention and support
 - o Re-establish an AIM coordinator to provide Gordon State College nursing students with academic intervention and support to improve academic performance and student success with a focus on assisting students to successfully complete the nursing program and pass the nursing NCLEX-RN licensure examination.
- 6. Establish a full time DON with a teaching workload of 6 hours or less per semester.
 - o This would allow the DON to focus more time on the administration of the nursing programs.
- 7. Utilization of Kaplan NCLEX Prep Resources
 - o Specific to the 4th semester ASN courses:
 - i. Increase the number of NCLEX prep quizzes and exams required throughout the semester.
 - ii. Integrate the NCLEX review course into the end of the semester course work to increase attendance. Increase remediation required of students after NCLEX style quizzes.
 - iii. Revise course-grading rubrics to place a bigger emphasis on NCLEX prep versus projects and papers.
- 8. The Nursing Department has transitioned to the use of Kaplan resources instead of ATI to assist students in the completion of the nursing program and passing of the NCLEX-RN licensure examination.
 - o Some of the most recent actions will impact the cohort that will graduate in December 2023, with the majority testing in 2024. The evaluation process is ongoing.

Herzing University (BSN): EDUCATION 23

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. Covid-19 Pandemic
 - o Shift beginning March 13, 2020, to all online course delivery.
2. Integration of Concepts NU 449 - Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI) is embedded into the Integration of Concepts (NU 449) course. Students must successfully complete the ATI Capstone course and the Virtual-ATI modules to successfully complete the NU 449 course. The ATI Capstone course is used to provide additional learning opportunities related to clinical judgement and safe nursing practice.
 - o Weekly NCLEX Updates – Faculty and staff meet to discuss the seniors and their progression towards taking the NCLEX
 - o Two NCLEX coaches who meet with and help students review content deficits, counsel students on test-taking strategies, and provide guidelines on how to address distractors that prevent students from focusing on their studies.
 - o Additional resources - supplemental review books and subscriptions for NCLEX-RN preparation
 - o Hurst Live Review

- ATI Live Review
- 3. Course Rigor—Exhaustive course review for content and rigor is ongoing. The following strategies have been implemented:
 - Increase in percentage of formal assessments (exams and quizzes using NCLEX style questions) to 80% of total grade for all core nursing courses.
 - NCLEX preparation integrated within all nursing courses, i.e., use of ATI assessments/resources in each course and implementation of the First Fifteen Initiative within each course.
 - ATI assessments are utilized to evaluate student progress. Students engage in remediation and complete focused reviews on missed topics. Students can review content through textbooks, class notes, PowerPoint presentations, ATI review modules/books with online videos, animations, graphics, and tutorials.
 - Faculty provide remediation for course content for each student who earns a grade below 76%. All students are welcome to participate, but the remediation is required for students following below 76%.
- 4. Admission criteria (effective July 2021) is outlined below:
 - ATI-TEAS comprehensive score—at least 58
 - 2.8 GPA—increased from 2.5
 - Science course must have a grade of "B" or higher for acceptance (A&P I with lab, A&P II with lab, Chemistry, and Microbiology)
 - Science course must be taken within 5 years
 - No more than one failure of a nursing course from a previous nursing program
- 5. Communication
 - To facilitate better communication, the Program Chair will host monthly "Chats with the Chair". The "Chats with the Chair" serves as information sessions and are held monthly. During these sessions, students have an opportunity to hear about upcoming events, to receive updates on policies and expectations, and to present questions or concerns to the Program Chair.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(3) programs are required to submit a corrective action plan and participate in a site visit based on NCLEX performance. Program is currently on conditional approval (4-year NCLEX 75.72%). **I recommend acceptance of the report and a site visit for Spring 2022. See full report in board packet.**

North Georgia Technical College (PN): EDUCATION 11A

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

- 1. Student Engagement and Accountability**
 - Revise test remediation process. If testing below a 70% on chapter exams, student must show proof of remediation of material. This includes a student/faculty engagement session after chapter exams that includes a discussion of why the questions were answered incorrectly.
 - After the discussion, the student may sit for review remediation quiz through Blackboard online assessment. The student will have two attempts to make a 100%. If the student makes a 100%, five points will be added to the chapter exam.
 - Student/faculty signed acknowledgement that states student has completed a post-exam rational discussion and will sit for an online assessment to improve test grade by five points. This evaluation will prove student has improved chapter knowledge and test score before the chapter final exam.
- 2. Development of Critical Thinking Skills**
 - Implement additional case studies to bring clinical to the classroom. Use group activities to promote active learning. Use critical thinking maps to encourage progression of critical thinking competencies in the clinical experience. Class discussions for test-taking strategies for analyzing questions and identifying the best answer

- Weekly case studies relating to different body systems discussed in class discussions. Small group interaction role play given at the end of class discussion. Incorporate clinical scenarios and experiences using critical map assessments. NCLEX PN Review text to review the most current questions available and strategies for identifying key terms and answers involving individual and group discussions before progressing to the next body system.

3. **Decreased ATI Probability of Passing (POP) NCLEX- PN Scores**

- Use the NCLEX test plan when creating lesson plans. Monitor ATI engagement scores weekly to ensure student compliance. Student and faculty individual sessions will look at time management goals for the student to complete all ATI assignments. Faculty will include the ATI 7 Content Mastery Series Proctored Assessments across the curriculum and the Comprehensive Predictor in the last semester. The CP exam will be worth 20% of the grade for summer and future semesters. The expectation is that students achieve a 90% probability of passing on the CP-which would be a 99% predicted pass rate on the NCLEX.
- Data analysis worksheets to discuss the student's role in performance on the CMS proctored and Comprehensive Predictor exams. These worksheets can be reviewed along with required remediation for each CMS proctored exam and Comprehensive Predictor. Students will have two attempts for all exams. If unsuccessful on the first attempt, remediation is required before the second attempt. If no remediation, student will not be able to sit for second exam on CMS Proctored or Predictor exam.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(2)(b) A nursing education program, with Full Approval, must submit a written assessment and plan of action for review by the Board if the passing percentage of all first-time writers on the licensing examination is less than eighty (80) percent in a calendar year. (2021 NCLEX 79.41%). **I recommend acceptance of the report. See full report in board packet.**

Shorter College (BSN): EDUCATION 12

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. Teaching/Learning Testing Software

- Point of Learning Testing Software: PrepU by Lippincott. Requiring students to achieve level 5/8 on content at the junior level; 7/8 to 8/8 at the senior level. Also used in classroom to stimulate learning and critical thinking.
- Assessment Technologies Incorporated (ATI) Course Software: Incorporated Engage Fundamentals product into Foundations of Nursing course. These are short activities used in the classroom to help solidify and reinforce content.

2. Standardized Testing Software

- Assessment Technologies Incorporated (ATI) Testing Software: Incorporated Content Mastery Series (CMS) testing at course end of Foundations, Pharmacology, Mental Health, Pediatrics, Community Health, Adult Health, and Leadership courses. Exams calculated as portion of the course grade.
- Remediation based on ATI exam results: For students making below level 2 on ATI exams (indicative of content mastery), remediation required before progressing to the next semester. If a student receives a Level 1 result, they are required to complete five topic areas in which they were weak. For below Level 1, the requirement is ten topic areas.
- Practice Exams: Incorporated into courses with required remediation with points assigned as part of the course.

3. Teaching Strategies

- Simulation: Virtual Simulation (vSim) by Lippincott. Used in classroom to demonstrate content as well as individually for clinical experience make-up
- Simulation: Simulation lab scenarios. Simulation software (mid and high-fidelity simulators: MetiMan, Laerdal, Gaumard) used to enhance learning. Used in Adult Health Nursing, Vulnerable Populations (Mental Health),

Women's Health, and Pediatric courses. High stakes scenarios used in final semester to test critical thinking and skills acquisition.

- Skills: Skills trainers. Skills trainers (low and mid-level fidelity simulators) used for student practice and competency testing. Used in Foundations, Women's Health, Pediatrics, Pharmacology, Health Assessment, Pediatrics, Adult Health Nursing.
- Skills: Instituted nursing skills Boot Camp during the first three weeks of the first semester of nursing during the Junior year. Done to prepare students for clinical experiences.
- Case Studies: Incorporated case studies from KeithRN to assist in reinforcing content taught in lecture. Also, used as assignment for make-up clinical experiences.
- Interactive Modules/Video Cases: Incorporated Interactive Learning Modules and Video Cases from Lippincott into the Leadership course to provide case scenarios related to leadership topics.
- Skills: Skills modules: Lynn's Skills Modules Software by Lippincott. Video series of skills to view prior to perfected practice prior to competency check off. Equipped with testing software to test knowledge of skill prior to practice in skills lab.

4. NCLEX preparation

- ATI Capstone Review/Live Review/Virtual ATI: Instituted Capstone Review, Live Review, and Virtual ATI Review as NCLEX preparation for all students. Students will complete Capstone Review during Capstone Course in the final semester of the program. All students attend the ATI three-day live NCLEX review and complete the Virtual ATI "Green to Go" prior to release for NCLEX examination.
- PassPoint Review: Instituted PassPoint by Lippincott. PassPoint allows students to take NCLEX style questions.

5. Covid Changes

- Virtual Classes
- Virtual Clinical
 - Virtual Testing – All impacted good teaching practices

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(2)(b) A nursing education program, with Full Approval, must submit a written assessment and plan of action for review by the Board if the passing percentage of all first-time writers on the licensing examination is less than eighty (80) percent in a calendar year. (2021 NCLEX 71.43%). **I recommend acceptance of the report. See full report in board packet.**

Southern Regional Technical College (ADN): EDUCATION 14A

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. Admission Criteria
 - The cohorts included in these board scores were admitted without any admission test or HESI admission scores.
2. New Admission Criteria Implemented for Spring 2023 Cohort
 - Increase GPA to 3.0 from 2.8.
 - LPN Bridge students must have 6 months licensed nursing experience prior to acceptance.
 - A competitive process of 60% GPA and 40% HESI with the applicant date being the ultimate tiebreaker.
 - Use the same criteria for transfer students as for in-house students – 2-time unsuccessful attempts (W, D, F) are withdrawn from the program.
 - Readmits are put on the list behind students attempting the program for the first time.
 - 2-year rule – applies to all Health Sciences diplomas and degrees. We are using only Math, English, BIOL 2113/4 when considering the 2 unsuccessful attempts.
 - Admissions is using the entry term start date (of occupational courses) for the expiration of classes (5 years for Math and Science courses).

- Change the 5-year rule to 3 years if failed any ASN program.
- 3. General Education (Rigor)
 - **problem:** Twenty-three core students were not accepted into the program because they did not pass the HESI A & P section within two attempts (although they passed A & P classes and labs with A/B grades).
 - **Action to Implement:** This data has been presented to the VP of Student Affairs and Deans of Arts and Sciences and Health Sciences. Program is requesting that students at online A & P sections be limited and that advisors strongly encourage students to take at least the first A & P class and lab (Biology BIOL 2113/2113L, BIO 2114/2114L face to face) to show success in course before taking all online or hybrid.
- 4. Faculty retention secondary to faculty leaving to work in the nursing industry
 - Continue advertising for faculty vacancy and offer face to face mentoring
- 5. Teaching and Learning Clinical
 - During the pandemic both teaching and clinical were moved to online
 - Learning curve for faculty who had to immediately move their courses to 100% online
- 6. NCLEX preparation
 - The 2020-2021 cohort was unable to have a live review for the NCLEX
 - This cohort used UWorld, however it did not count for a grade
 - Hurtz will be providing face to face 3-day review, mandatory all students attend to graduate from the program
- 7. Program Testing
 - ATI Capstone Review/Live Review/Virtual ATI: Instituted Capstone Review, Live Review, and Virtual ATI will be added to the capstone in December 2022 for Bridge and Spring 2023 for Generic.
 - The program has made the decision to switch from HESI to Assessment Technologies Incorporated Testing Software (ATI). The incorporated Content Mastery Series (CMS) testing at course end of Fundamentals, Pharmacology, Mental Health, Women's Health, Pediatrics, Medical/Surgical Nursing, and Leadership. Exams will be calculated as a portion of the course grades. The program will only require a Level Two for program completion in the capstone course. The student will be allowed three attempts to achieve this Level Two.
- 8. Remediation was hard to do during the pandemic which limited resources faculty could use. Remediation is now done face to face.
- 9. Professional Development - This was cancelled for faculty during the pandemic and is limited now.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(2)(b) A nursing education program, with Full Approval, must submit a written assessment and plan of action for review by the Board if the passing percentage of all first-time writers on the licensing examination is less than eighty (80) percent in a calendar year. (2021 NCLEX 76.92%). **I recommend acceptance of the report. See full report in board packet.**

Southern Regional Technical College (PN): EDUCATION 15

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. Admission Requirements

- College Admission Requirements
- PN Program Admission Requirements
 - Pre-requisite Courses
 - Pre-admission Testing
 - HESI – three sections including Math, English, and Anatomy & Physiology
 - maintaining a minimum of a “C” (70% or 2.0) overall GPA
 - Plan to increase GPA from 2.0 to 2.8
 - Five pre-requisite classes
 - All PN candidates that pass the HESI & all five pre-requisite courses (within the above guidelines) will be reviewed,
 - Increase HESI A-2 Exam from 70% to 78%

- These applicants are then ranked by total number of points from the required five pre-requisite course grades,
- Acceptance is based on highest number of points (high to low) on the five pre-requisite courses until the class is full.

2. Instructional Environment: In-Person vs. Online

- The Fall 2019 Entry/Summer 2020 Graduation cohort spent one-half of the three-semester program In-Person and one-half Online. The first half of the program (foundational courses) were spent In-Person and the second half online. Five students from this cohort tested for the first time six months after program completion with a pass rate of 100%. The cohort spent The Spring 2020 Entry/Fall 2020 cohort spent 2.5 of 3 semesters in an Online Environment with Preadmission Testing with a 53% pass rate.
- Fall 2020 Entry/Summer 2021 graduation cohort: No Preadmission Testing. Spent 1.75 semesters in an online environment (foundational courses and beginning 3 Med/Surg courses) and 1.25 of 3 semesters In-Person for the last Med/Surg, Maternity & Leadership courses. These students were required to come to a specified class time upon program completion to register for the NCLEX-PN. Cohort pass rate of 57.70%.
- Spring 2021 Entry/Fall 2021 graduation cohort: Spent 0.75 hours Online (Pharmacology and Foundations) and 2.25 of 3 semester hours In-person with Preadmission Testing. These students were required to come to a specified class time upon program completion to register for the NCLEX-PN. Fifteen students have taken the NCLEX-PN to date in CY 2022. Cohort pass rate of 57.70% (13 passed and 2 did not.
- This impacted student success.

3. Curriculum Sequencing, Curriculum and Course Materials, and Grading Requirements

○ Curriculum Sequencing

The PN nursing courses (content and clinical courses) are sequenced to be completed in three (3) semesters with admissions occurring each Fall (TIF, THO, BLAKELY) and Spring (MOU, Bainbridge). Graduating student cohorts occur every Summer (Tifton, Thomasville, Blakely) and Fall (Moultrie, Bainbridge) semesters (please see Attachment 1.a and 1.b

4. Testing Practices

○ Nursing Examination Procedures

A comprehensive final exam is administered at the end of each PNSG course. These exams are used to assess a student's overall comprehension and application of content that correlates with the PN Program curriculum, textbooks, and resources.

- The student is allowed one attempt for the course comprehensive final exam.
- Course and clinical component are blocked together, therefore, if the course is failed, the clinical course will be counted as a failure as well.
- Testing Guidelines for All Examinations for In-Person Testing
 - All exams are computer based. No written exams given.
 - HESI Developed Exams: HESI developed exams are comprehensive in nature and are supported by evidenced-based research. The HESI Examinations are predictive of First-Time Test Taker success on the NCLEX-PN Licensure Examination. The HESI Comprehensive Final Examination grade within the PNSG 2030, PNSG 2220, and PNSG 2240 courses is weighted at 35% of the course grade. The student's Comprehensive Final Examination grade that will be entered into the gradebook is the student's earned HESI generated Percent Conversion Score.

5. Practical Nursing Review Course and/or Test-Taking Strategies Offerings to Students

- Test-Taking strategies are offered during the first semester courses. Students are requested to complete a Test-Taking Self-Assessment that is incorporated in the cloud-based product: HESI Case Studies. This additional individualized self-assessment offers the student an individualized learning and test-taking results as well as strategies upon submission of the self-assessment. Faculty reinforce learning and test-taking strategies based upon the student's learning style.

- Students who score less than 70 % on any Instructor-developed or HESI-developed comprehensive final exam or exit exam must complete a remediation plan that is reviewed with the course instructor.
- A Live or Virtual NCLEX-PN is provided to students (depending on COVID precautions at that time), during the last semester course: PNSG 2410 (Nursing Leadership). This course is a 2-day course presented by Elsevier HESI. All students are required to participate in this review. The Live or
- Add HURST In-Person Review in the Leadership Capstone Course

6. Faculty Turnover

From June 1, 2021 – August 2021, PN experienced a fifty percent turnover among faculty. This was five instructors. Of the five instructors, three moved to the university system, one retired, and one transferred to another program. The hired faculty all come very well qualified with more current hospital practice and enthusiasm.

7. NCLEX-Pass Rate by Campus Location

Pass Rates have progressively declined by all campus locations with the SRTC-Tifton Campus maintained a pass rate above 80% consistently.

According to Board Rule 410-9-.03(2)(b) programs are required to submit a corrective action plan and participate in a site visit based on NCLEX performance. Program is currently on conditional approval (4-year NCLEX 75.64%). **I recommend acceptance of the report and a site visit for Spring 2022. See full report in board packet.**

Toccoa Falls College (BSN): EDUCATION 16

The program submitted a report which included:

Areas of Concern and Plans for Improvement:

1. Curricular changes -

- Implemented beginning in Fall 2022. One course was removed from the plan of study, another course was divided into two courses, three courses had credit hour increases, and three other courses had adjustments in credit hours specific to clinical the clinical component.
- PHY 333 Bioethics – removed from the fall semester, junior level
- NUR 456 Childbearing and Family –
 - Decommissioned and content placed in two separate courses
 - NUR 354 – Maternal-Newborn Nursing – spring semester, junior level
 - NUR 454 – Pediatric Nursing – fall semester, senior level
- Program-wide clinical credit hours were
 - Reduced from 19 credit hours (or 855 clock hours) to 16 credit hours (or 720 clock hours). Clinical hours for the following courses were reduced from two credit hours (or 90 clock hours) down to one credit hour (or 45 clock hours).
 - Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing
 - Community/Public Health Nursing
 - Care of the Complex Patient Across the Lifespan

Credit hours for the following courses (specific to time in the classroom) were increased one credit hour each to allow for additional time for content.

- Pathophysiology and Pharmacology I and II
- Capstone Integration
- Adult Health Care II

2. At-risk Students

- Beginning in Fall 2021, efforts were made to better identify and assist students who were at-risk for being unsuccessful. As part of this plan, an adjunct faculty member meets with students on an individual basis to offer additional academic support and remediation on top of the support offered by the individual course faculty members.

- Around the midpoint of the fall semester 2021, the adjunct faculty member met with any student who failed more than one exam across all the courses for the semester. She reviewed exams with those students and offered test-taking strategies for future exams. She continued to meet with these students for the remainder of the semester.

3. New Student Resources

- Since the beginning of the program (August 2017), HESI products such as Case Studies and Practice Tests, Clinical Essentials, and Specialty and Exit testing, have been integrated throughout the curriculum. Feedback from students indicated that those resources were not overly robust. After researching other options, the decision was made to partner with ATI beginning with the current junior cohort. Due to the contract that is currently in place with HESI, the senior cohort will continue using HESI products.
- ATI offers a variety of resources such as testing and remediation products, curriculum supplements, and clinical prep resources. ATI also offers NCLEX prep products. The feedback from the current junior cohort is excitement to have the ATI resources available to them
- While the current senior cohort remains on HESI products, the end-of-program review will be completed through the incorporation of ATI's Virtual ATI product. All seniors will participate in the Virtual ATI program and will be encouraged to finish the product prior to taking NCLEX. However, any senior student not meeting the benchmark score of 900 or greater on one of the four HESI Exit Exams will be required to complete the Virtual ATI program to earn the "green light" before being cleared to take NCLEX after graduation.

4. Program Admission

- The grade point average (GPA) requirement for admission to the nursing program has been increased for 3.0/4.0 to 3.25/4.0 secondary to data collection regarding outcomes. Most graduates who had an admission GPA of 3.25 or higher passed NCLEX on their first attempt. Therefore, beginning Fall 2022, the admission GPA for the nursing program will be a minimum of 3.25/4.0.
- Nursing program applicants will take the ATI TEAS as part of the admission requirements for the Fall 2022 cohort, instead of the HESI A2 Admission Exam.
- With the admission of the junior cohort in August 2021, students are no longer granted program admission without all pre-requisite courses being completed, except for those courses specific to Bible and Theology.

According to Board Rule 410-8-.02(3) programs are required to submit a corrective action plan and participate in a site visit based on NCLEX performance. Program is currently on conditional approval (4-year NCLEX 62.03%). **I recommend acceptance of the report and a site visit for Spring 2022. See full report in board packet.**

Waivers (Education)

NAME: Chamberlain University, College of Nursing, Atlanta Campus

ISSUE: Chamberlain respectfully requests to allow qualified nurses, appointed by a clinical institution, the ability to manage a clinical group of up to 6 students. These students would be under the guidance of an academic leader at the Chamberlain - Atlanta Campus. This qualified nurse would be paid by the clinical institution during the clinical experience but would not be counted as part of the staffing model. The staff nurse would instead be considered a nurse clinical instructor during the time spent with the students.

Applicant is requesting that the Board for a variance: **Rule 410-8-.06.9** which states:

The preceptor shall interact with no more than two (2) students at any given time.

This waiver was withdrawn.

NAME: **Albany Technical College – Associate of Science in Nursing Program**

ISSUE: Albany Technical College has had a marked decrease in faculty over the last 24 months due to faculty going back in to practice secondary to COVID. This has impacted the number of students able to be admitted each year. At present ATC has two full time faculty and a full-time administrator. The goal of the ASN Program is to increase the number of nursing faculty members, full and part-time, to accommodate the current number of potential students interested in pursuing a career as an RN during this desperate time of need. To accomplish this goal, the ASN program would like to work with its' community partner, PPMH, by utilizing their graduate prepared nurses currently on staff as part-time nursing faculty to fill the current gap until full-time nursing faculty can be acquired.

Applicant is requesting that the Board for a variance: **Rule 410-8-.05(6)** which states:

For any given academic term, the nursing education program must be able to provide evidence that at least the majority of faculty members are full time and that at least three-fourths of individual full-time and part-time faculty members hold one (1) or more earned graduate degrees in nursing.

The Board Approved this waiver which will extend until the governor signs the new rules.




