<u>Public Hearing - Policy VIII - Georgia Law Effective July 1, 2022 - Counselors</u> 10:45 A.M. Ms. Smith called the Public Rules Hearing to Order at 10:45 a.m.

The Board received 10 correspondences regarding the proposed new policy, Policy VIII New Law – Counselors, during the minimum thirty (30) days pre-hearing posting of the policy. Each of the 10 correspondences received was read by the Chair for the guests to hear. Many of the authors of the correspondences were present, some spoke, others did not. Following the discussion regarding the proposed new policy, including the correspondences received, and the guest's oral feedback, the Chair called for a vote. The Board voted to adopt the following proposed policy as posted, with one additional alternative discussed based on the written and Oral feedback received during the hearing to be added to the final referral to the Governor's office.

Mr. Herrin motioned, Ms. Barker seconded, and the Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 43-1-2(k) (1) (2), O.C.G.A. § 50-14-2(1), O.C.G.A. § 43-1-2-(k) (4), O.C.G.A. § 43-1-19 (h) (2) & (4) for further discussion of the adoption of Policy VIII with the Boards legal counsel prior to a final vote. Voting in favor of the motion were Board members present Smith, Barker, Gresham, Brown-Pinkney, Lane, Herrin and Moffatt.

At the conclusion of Executive Session on Friday, September 9, 2022 Ms. Smith, declared the meeting into "open" session pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act O.C.G.A. § 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken in Executive Session.

In open session again, the Chair called for a vote on the Policy:

Ms. Barker motioned, Mr. Moffatt seconded, and the Board voted five in favor, two opposed, to adopt Policy VIII with the following alternative to be included with the referral to the Governor's office for oversight of this policy: The Board is in agreement that APCs licensed before July 1, 2022 who meet the educational and directed work experience under supervision requirements in the new language of the law

effective July 1, 2022, may proceed upon application for LPC licensure by completing/verifying 2 years of Directed Work Experience hours with appropriate Supervision hours. The APCs licensed before July 1, 2022, who do not meet the current educational requirements may move forward in the LPC licensing process by completing the approved 3 years of Directed Work Experience with appropriate Supervision. None opposed, motion carried.

Policy VIII. Georgia Law Effective July 1, 2022 – Counselors

A. Applications and Licensure received and date stamped on or before June 30, 2022:

Individuals who submitted an application for initial licensure as an **Associate Professional Counselor or Licensed Professional Counselor (APC/LPC)** which was <u>received and date stamped</u> by the Professional Licensing Board division staff <u>on or before June 30, 2022</u>, shall be required to meet the prior statutory licensure requirements and Board rules for education and directed work experience in effect prior to July 1, 2022. Specifically, in addition to other requirements, to include those previously outlined in O.C.G.A. § 43-10A-11(a), the following shall be required:

For licensure as an Associate Professional Counselor:

A master's degree from a recognized educational institution in a program that is primarily counseling in
content or in a program of applied psychology, which degree includes a supervised internship or
practicum as part of the degree program and registration with the board of an acceptable contract for
obtaining the post-master's experience under direction and supervision required for licensure as a
professional counselor.

For licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor (not previously licensed as an APC):

- A doctoral degree from a recognized educational institution in a program that is primarily counseling in content and requires at least one-year of a supervised internship in a work setting acceptable to the Board; or
- A specialist degree from a recognized educational institution in a program that is primarily counseling in content with supervised internship or practicum and two-years of post-master's directed experience under supervision in a setting acceptable to the Board; or
- A master's degree in rehabilitation counseling or in a program that is primarily counseling in content from a recognized educational institution with supervised internship or practicum and three years of postmasters directed experience providing rehabilitation services in a rehabilitation setting under supervision. Up to one year of such experience may have been in an approved practicum or internship placement as part of the degree program; or
- A master's degree from a recognized educational institution in a program that is primarily counseling in content with supervised internship or practicum and four years of post-masters directed experience under supervision in a setting acceptable to the Board. Up to one year of such experience may have been in an approved practicum placement as part of the degree program: or
- A master's degree from a recognized educational institution in a program of applied psychology with supervised internship or practicum and four years of post-masters directed experience under supervision in a setting acceptable to the Board. Up to one year of such experience may have been in an approved practicum placement as part of the degree program.

For licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor (previously licensed as an APC)

Individuals submitting an application for a Licensed Professional Counselor license who were previously licensed by the Board as an Associate Professional Counselor based on an application for APC licensure received and date stamped on or before June 30, 2022, and their educational and directed work experience requirements having already been approved by the Board, shall not be subject to the new statutory provisions for the educational degree or number of years of directed work experience under supervision. Their application for a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) license shall be reviewed and processed pursuant only to the statutory requirements and Board rules in place on and before June 30, 2022, regardless of their date of application. Specifically, the statutory requirements to become licensed as a Licensed Professional Counselor, for these referenced individuals, shall include the following:

A master's degree from a recognized educational institution in a program that is primarily counseling in
content or in a program of applied psychology, with supervised internship or practicum and four years of
post-masters directed experience under supervision in a setting acceptable to the Board. Up to one year of
such experience may have been in an approved practicum placement as part of the degree program.

B. Applications and Licensure received and date stamped on or after July 1, 2022:

Individuals submitting an application for an initial license as an **Associate Professional Counselor** <u>or</u> **Licensed Professional Counselor** (**APC/LPC**) <u>received and date stamped</u> by the Professional Licensing Board Division <u>on or after July 1, 2022</u> shall be required to meet the new statutory provisions for licensure (and any Board rules promulgated after July 1, 2022). Specifically, these applicants, in addition to other requirements outlined in O.C.G.A. § 43-10A-11(a), must demonstrate the following:

For licensure as an Associate Professional Counselor:

- A minimum of an earned master's degree or higher from a regionally accredited program in clinical
 counseling or counseling psychology that consists of at least 60 semester hours or 80 quarter hours
 with an approved supervised internship or practicum that is primarily counseling in content as part of the
 degree program; and
- Registration with the Board of an acceptable contract for obtaining the post-degree experience under direction and supervision that is required for licensure as a professional counselor.

For licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor:

- A minimum of an earned master's degree or higher from a regionally accredited program in clinical
 counseling or counseling psychology that consists of at least 60 semester hours or 80 quarter hours
 with an approved supervised internship or practicum that is primarily counseling in content as part of the
 degree program; and
- **Two years** of post-degree experience under direction and supervision in a work setting acceptable to the Board; or
- A doctoral degree from a recognized educational institution in a program that is primarily counseling in content and requires at least one-year of a supervised internship in a work setting acceptable to the Board.

Including an additional alternative to the above policy acceptable to the Board: The Board is in agreement that APCs licensed before July 1, 2022, who meet the educational and directed work experience under supervision

requirements in the new language of the law effective July 1, 2022, may proceed upon application for LPC licensure by completing/verifying 2 years of Directed Work Experience hours with appropriate Supervision hours. The APCs licensed before July 1, 2022, who do not meet the current educational requirements may move forward in the LPC licensing process by completing the approved 3 years of Directed Work Experience with appropriate Supervision.

Authority: O.C.G.A. 43-10A-5(c) and the need to avoid Constitutional concerns with respect to individuals due process rights.

Mr. Herrin motioned, Mr. Carrier seconded and the Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 43-1-2(k) (1) (2), O.C.G.A. § 50-14-2(1), O.C.G.A. § 43-1-2-(k) (4), O.C.G.A. § 43-1-19 (h) (2) & (4) to conduct the denied applicant interviews, receive and review information pertaining to applications, receive reports from the Assistant Attorney General, the Professional Practices (Complaints), the Professional Standards (Applications) Committees and review prior meeting executive session meeting minutes. Voting in favor of the motion were Board members present Smith, Brown, Gresham, Brown-Pinkney, Lane, Herrin and Moffatt.
