The Board accepted the Attorney General's Report as presented, which included information on any cases referred for action, requests for advice, and requests for authority for proposed rules.

OPEN SESSION:

Other Business:

Certificate of Active Supervision:

The Board reviewed the certificate of active supervision from the Governor's office, dated October 25, 2022, approving the amendment to Rule 509-4-.01.

Vetoed Rule Amendments:

The Board reviewed and discussed the certificate of active supervision from the Governor's office dated September 20, 2022, vetoing the amendment to Rule 509-2-.02, after having received clarification from the Governor's office on the reason for the veto. The Board unanimously voted to resume review of this rule at the January 26, 2023 Board meeting.

Name Change Request:

The Board reviewed a name change request from Emergency Crime Prevention (PSC002212), requesting that the Board approve the name of the company to be changed to Metro Atlanta Public Safety. Tripp Mitchell moved, Tim Smith seconded, and the Board unanimously voted to deny the request citing Board Rule 509-4-.03, and noting that the Board believes that this name is likely to give the general public the impression that the agency is a public law enforcement agency or government entity.

Event Staffing Agencies:

The Board unanimously voted to table discussion on event staffing agencies until the January 26, 2023 Board meeting.

Executive Director's Report

The Board reviewed the Executive Director's report which provided statistical data regarding licensing, complaints, and examinations.


The next meeting of the Georgia Board of Private Detectives and Security Agencies will be held Thursday, January 26, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
