

# **Georgia Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors Board**

Open Session Minutes Thursday, December 14, 2023, 9:30 A.M.

The Georgia Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors Board met on Thursday, December 14, 2023, in person and via Webex.

### **Call to Order**

At 9:29 a.m., Board Chairman Darien Sykes declared that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

#### **OPEN SESSION**

# Public Hearing for 180-11-.03:

Chairman Darien Sykes called the public hearing to amend 180-11-.03 to order at 9:30 a.m. All board members present introduced themselves. Darren Mickler presented the changes, which outlined continuing education. requirements for annual renewals. Professional engineers and dual registrants are required to obtain 15 professional developments hours annually, allowing up to 7.5 hours to be carried over from the previous year. Land surveyors are required to obtain 7.5 professional development hours annually, allowing up to 3.75 hours to be carried over from the previous year. It was determined that the rule would add no additional costs to the licensees. A motion was made by Womack, seconded by Busbee, and the Board voted unanimously to adopt the amendments to Board Rule 180-11-.03 as presented. None opposed, motion carried. The rule amendments will be sent to the Governor's office for the approval process.

#### **Approval of Open Minutes**

A motion was made by Wright, seconded by Davis, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the Open Session minutes from the Board meeting on October 12, 2023.

#### **British Consulate**

Guests from the British Consulate, Philipp Clarke and Colin Gray, spoke briefly about seeking the Board's support for the mutual recognition of qualifications through NCEES to make it easier for Chartered Engineers (CEng) from the United Kingdom, and for Georgia Professional Engineers to have path to licensure to work in the other country.

# **Decoupling Discussion**

The Board briefly discussed decoupling, which would allow applicants to take the required exam (PE or LS) before gaining the required experience. Currently, statute does not allow for decoupling. Guest from SAMSOG, Trent Turk, spoke on the legislation changes pending to be presented in January regarding requirements for land surveyors, which involves decoupling to allow surveyors to take the exams before gaining the required experience. The Board members present indicated an unofficial preference toward decoupling for engineers well. The next steps would be to start the process of making changes to the current statute.

#### Changes to the Engineer-In-Training Application

Darren Mickler presented changes to the Engineer-In-Training application. Changes include eliminating the reference signatures and simplifying the application to include a demographics page, college transcript, and passing Fundamentals of Engineering scores. A motion to accept the changes was made by Davis, seconded by Womack. None opposed, motion carried.

#### <u>Committee Reports – Updates</u>

- Personnel Committee: An interview will be scheduled for Deputy Director position. Two analyst
  positions have been posted; one has been filled by Ashley Elander. Investigator positions were
  discussed. One will be made chief investigator, who will have to take required class work to become
  chief.
- **Budget Committee:** Amendments are being made to FY24 and FY25 budget. The committee met with the senate budget office to discuss all services that will need to be replicated after parting from the Secretary of State's Office.
- **Technology Committee:** Web designers are working on the public website. The desired domain for the public website is pels.ga.gov. The committee is having weekly meetings with System Automations, who is building the licensing software for the Board. All application processes will be available online and will send SMS updates to update applicants during the application process. A small group will be selected for beta testing to ensure functionality of the licensing software at the time of launch.
- Real Estate Committee: The space chosen for the new Board office is 229 Peachtree Street, Atlanta GA, 30303. The committee is in the process of working with state properties commission to finalize the lease. Lease projected to begin mid-January or February. The committee received a quote from one of the furniture companies. Once the lease is signed, furniture can be ordered.

### **Executive Director's Report**

Darren Mickler updated the board on renewals – 46 percent of licenses have been renewed. He informed the Board that he received approval to continue using Information Technology services provided by the Secretary of State's Office until IT personnel can be hired. He then presented a list of licenses issued for 2023 so far, which indicated 2857 licenses issued in total. He briefly discussed the possibility of board becoming member of the Georgia Engineering Alliance (GEAA), which lead to the board taking a vote to join.

#### Joining GEAA

A motion was made by Wright, seconded by Davis, and the Board voted unanimously to request to join GEAA with Executive Director Darren Mickler as liaison. None opposed, motion carried.

#### **Other Board Discussion Items:**

- Updates regarding amendments to 180-7-.07 Maps and Plats were discussed. The amended rule has been sent to the Governor's Office.
- The Board discussed making amendments to 180-11-.06 regarding recordkeeping. The Board expressed the desire for more consistency in disciplining licensees who fail to meet the continuing education requirements. Max Changus advised that this should be outlined in the Board rules instead of being added as a Board policy. He further advised that the Board cannot suspend an individual's license without first sending notice and having a hearing. The Board discussed the possibility of establishing an initial fine of \$500 for those who do not satisfy the requirements, and after six months, sending a notice of hearing if the required continuing education has not been obtained. Licenses will then be suspended until licensees are compliant with continuing education requirements. Max Changus will work on language for the rule change and bring it back to the Board. The Board also discussed the possibility of using the NCEES tracker as the main way of tracking continuing education. Further discussion is needed.
- The Board discussed possible updates to 180-12-.02 regarding the sealing of documents. The rule talks about electronic signatures, but requirements describe digital signatures. Wright discussed the difference between the two and stated that the Board does not require digital signatures.
- The Board received notice from NCEES that Trent Thompson, a candidate for the PE exam, continued
  working on the exam after time had been called. NCEES invalidated his exam scores. A motion was made
  by Davis, seconded by Womack, and the Board voted unanimously to accept the invalidation of the
  exam scores. None opposed, motion carried.
- The Board elected officers for 2024. Taylor Wright was recommended for chairman, and Dan Davis was recommended for vice chair. A motion was made by Womack, seconded by Busbee, and the Board voted unanimously to accept the recommendations for 2024 officers. None opposed, motion carried.
- The Board selected meeting dates for 2024. Meetings were scheduled for the following dates:

A motion was made by Wright, seconded by Womack, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the scheduled meeting dates for 2024. None opposed, motion carried.

The Board discussed the 2024 NCEES Southern Zone Meeting, April 11-13, Asheville, NC. All board
members plan to attend. NCEES has provided three funded positions for board members or associate
members. The board discussed funding the additional spots for board members and select staff to
attend.

#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

At 11:43 a.m., Womack moved, Davis seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k), 43-1-19(h), and 50-14-2(1) to review executive session minutes, executive session correspondence, applications, investigative matters, and the Attorney General's status report.

Executive Session concluded at 12:13 p.m., chairman Darien Sykes declared the meeting to be "open" pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during Executive Session.

#### **Approval of Executive Session Minutes**

Chairman Darien Sykes presented a draft of the Executive Session minutes from the Board meeting on October 12, 2023. Womack made a motion for the Board to approve the minutes with no edits. Davis seconded. None opposed, motion carried.
