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### **General Information:**

The post-election survey of Georgia voters was conducted November 11-20, 2024 and included a total of 1,541 Georgia registrants who self-reported as having voted in the 2024 general election. The live interviewer telephone survey was administered by the School of Public and International Affairs Survey Research Center at the University of Georgia. Interviews were conducted in English. A dual-frame statewide random sample consisting of approximately 93% cell phone numbers and 7% landline numbers was obtained through L2 (L2 is a sampling vendor that maintains a database constructed from state voter registration lists. Through commercial sources, phone numbers have been appended to the individual records (registrants) that make up these lists). The survey results were weighted using iterative proportional raking in order to ensure the sample was representative of the 2024 electorate in terms of education, race, sex, and age, and political party. The calculated margin of error for the total sample is +/-2.5 points at the 95% confidence level. This would mean that if 50% of respondents indicate a topline view on an issue, we can be 95% confident that the population's view on that issue is somewhere between 52.5% and 47.5%. 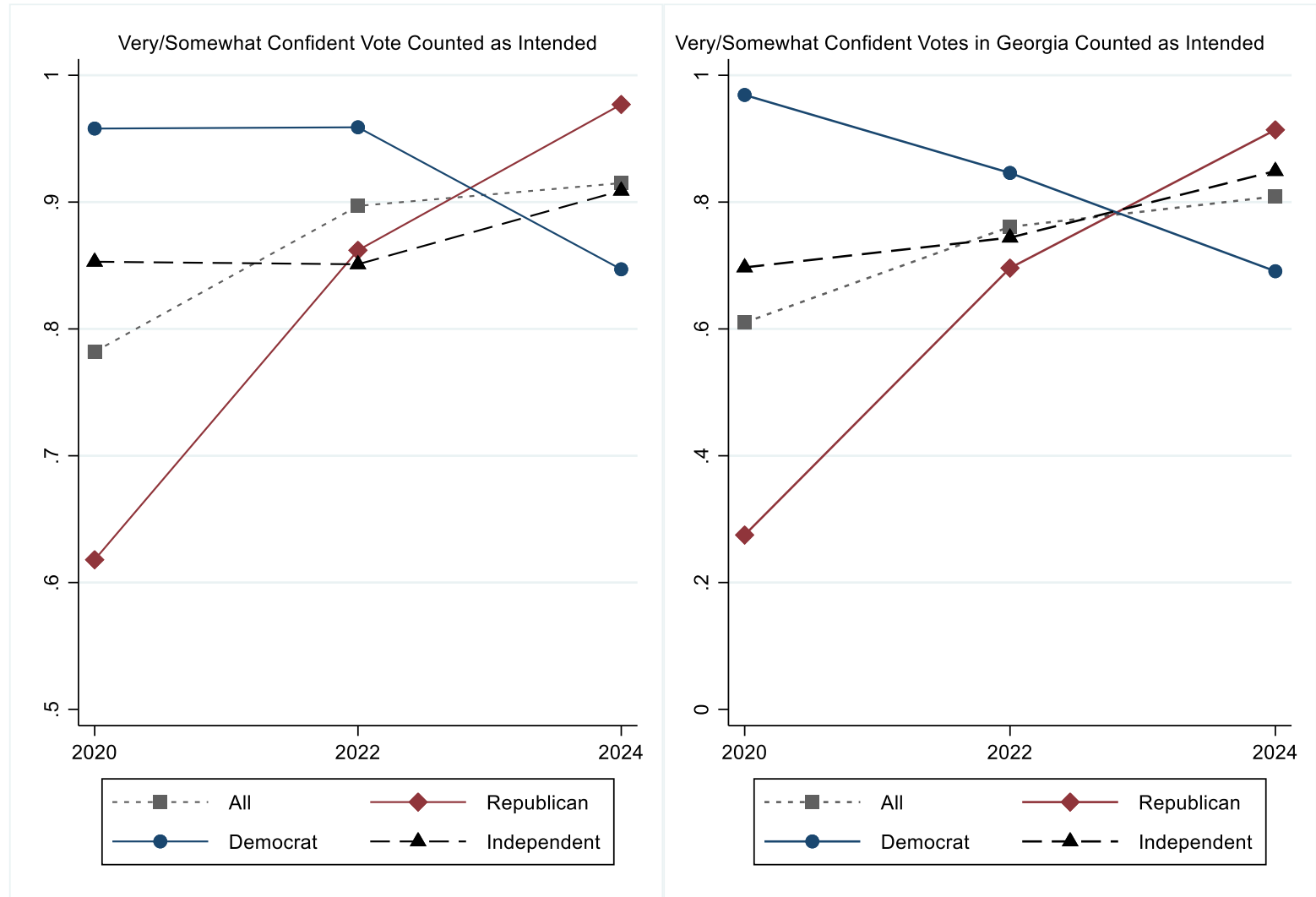
