EVALUATION AND FUTURE REVIEW OF IMPACT OF NEW RULE

The Board Chair emphasized the need to monitor the impact of the rule reducing the required experience for a Journeyman Plumber from 3 years to 1 year. In particular, the Board will evaluate exam pass/fail rates and workforce entry feedback once the rule takes effect. A special meeting will be scheduled as soon as possible after the third anniversary of the rule change to assess its effects. If the pass rate declines or other concerns arise, the Board may re-evaluate the experience requirement.
