Given a recent communication from Director Searls, it was requested that the Georgia Composite Board of Professional Counselors, Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists (henceforth the "Board") clarify for Director Searls the roles of the Composite Board in Georgia and the Licensed Professional Counselors Association (LPCA).

The Composite Board is a state board under the umbrella of the Secretary of State's office that is tasked to "ensure the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the people of this state." The board has ten members who are appointed by the Governor of Georgia. The members are tasked with writing rules that support the laws that regulate the practice of counseling. The Governor has tasked the board to regulate the profession of Licensed Professional Counselors (LPCs) in GA. The Composite Board has an Executive Director, Amanda Allen, an attorney assigned through the Attorney General's office, and staff that work to support the board's mission. The Executive Director is tasked with overseeing the board's functions, licensing logistics, and many other duties.

LPCA is a professional association that is tasked with promoting and furthering the profession as reflected in their mission statement, "to empower Licensed Professional Counselors by providing leadership, advocacy, and resources that enhance professional excellence and advance mental health in Georgia." Through their efforts, Georgia became the first state to join the Compact, and LPCA has been a champion of this process from its inception. Their role is to advocate for the profession, but they do not regulate the profession.

Given the roles of the Composite Board and the LPCA, and ongoing discussions between Director Searls and LPCA regarding the best way for LPC's to give consent for a federal criminal background check (a requirement by The Compact to obtain multistate licensure privileges) and fingerprinting procedures, the Board believes it is important to keep in mind the roles of the Composite Board and LPCA. Specifically, the Board will make all decisions relating to workflow procedures, rules, and processes regarding LPC licensees in Georgia. LPCA has no regulatory authority in Georgia. Since LPCA has no regulatory authority, its input would not be binding on the Board. All Board correspondences/inquiries submitted to the Governor's office are forwarded to the Board for a response. Therefore, the Board encourages the Compact to communicate directly with the Board. In regard to ongoing discussions regarding Licensed

Professional Counselors, completing federal criminal background checks and fingerprinting procedures as a prerequisite to becoming part of the Compact, the Board is diligently working to establish processes and procedures to establish background checks. The Board encourages an open line of communication between Compact Commission and the Board about this subject and all future subjects. At the recommendation of Ms. Kim Speakman, Chair of the Compact, we, the Board, request that Amanda Allen, Executive Director, be copied on all communication between Director Searls and LPCAGA to help facilitate this communication.
