BOARD ORDERS

OPEN CORRESPONDENCE

The Board received an inquiry about licensure for performing cathodic protection work.

The Board's Response:

It is the consensus of the Board that the cathodic protection process itself is not within the Board's primary jurisdiction, as the voltage involved is minimal and largely incidental. The key factor is the sacrificial anodes and the active system responsible for providing and regulating the cathodic protection.

While the actual protection voltage is negligible, the equipment that generates and monitors the protective current does fall under the Board's licensing authority. Therefore, while cathodic protection as a concept is not the Board's concern, the active electrical components used in its implementation do fall within the Board's purview.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

La Trenda Tyler-Jones, Executive Director, reported on the active license counts, GOALS, pass/fail rates for 2024, and an update on GA HB635 (legislation).
