**Discussion** on Proposed Rule Change to Rule 85-2-.02 Weight Classes. Following a breakdown of the proposed change, Commissioner Smith makes a motion to approve. Commissioner Millican seconds, and the Commission votes 4-0 to approve. This proposal will be sent for legal review.

**Discussion** on Proposed Rule Change to Rule 85-3-.01 Weight Classes. Following a breakdown of the proposed change, Commissioner Smith makes a motion to approve. Commissioner Millican seconds, and the Commission votes 4-0 to approve. This proposal will be sent for legal review.

**Discussion** on Removal of +2 allowance on contract. Commissioner Millican makes a motion to remove the +/- 2 from all contracts effective July 1, 2026. Instructs the Executive Director to draft a memo and send out to all promoters and gyms letting them know about the change. Commissioner Smith seconds, and the Commission votes 4-0.

**Discussion** on Maurice Montgomery acting as a boxing manager while unlicensed. After hearing the evidence, Commissioner Millican makes a motion to refer to the Secretary of State Investigations division to serve Mr. Montgomery a Cease and Desist. Vice Chairman Haraszti seconds, and the Commission votes 4-0.

**Discussion** on sparring events at Gwinnett Training Academy. After hearing the evidence and statements from Mr. Hecimovic, Vice Chairman Haraszti makes a motion to send an informed letter to Gwinnett Training Academy about regulated events as well as refer to the Secretary of State Investigations division to serve a Cease and Desist. Commissioner Millican seconds, and the Commission votes 4-0.
