RE: Policy on Medical/License Application Deadline

Everyone,

The Georgia Athletic and Entertainment Commission (hereinafter "Commission") has issued a policy, effective immediately. This policy is regarding a contestants medicals and license application deadline for submission.

Policy Update for Medical Deadline:

All contestants scheduled to compete in Boxing, Bare-Knuckle Boxing, Mixed Martial Arts, or Muay Thai/Kickboxing must submit all required medical evaluations to the Commission before weigh-ins begin.

Policy Update for License Application Deadline:

License applications must be initiated no later than two (2) days before the scheduled start of weigh-ins and fully submitted by the completion of the weigh in. In order to weigh in, the license application must be submitted.

The Commission may grant an exemption where circumstances beyond the contestant's or promoter's control prevent timely submission, including last-minute contestant replacements.
