Tripp Mitchell moved, David Sawyer seconded, and the Board voted to ratify the licenses issued between meetings in accordance with Board Rules and Policies.

Agency Review

A public hearing was held by the Board. At 9:36 a.m. Brad Coman, Executive Director of the Board, called to order the Agency Review of the Initial Decision in the matter of Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies v Dereck Bradley and Gideon Corps International, LLC. The initial hearing of the matter was held on November 14, 2025, with the Office of State Administrative Hearings. This is a review of the Initial Decision made by Administrative Law Judge, Shakara M. Barnes to affirm the Board's decision to impose fines for violation of a cease-and-desist order.

The Board heard testimony from both the respondent's attorney, Ashley B. Johnson-Alford, and Kareem McCulley, Assistant Attorney General. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Board unanimously voted to enter into Executive Session at 10:14 a.m. to deliberate. At 10:17 a.m. the Board declared the meeting to be "open". The Board unanimously voted in agreement with the Initial Decision Docket No. 2546745.

The Board reviewed the Executive Director's report which provided statistical data regarding licensing, complaints, and examinations.

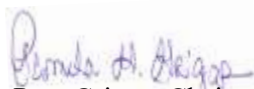
