

## How to report Dry Needling hours

A Physical Therapist has demonstrated specific and competent education and training in dry needling when the licensee has submitted the following documentation to the Board through their free CE Broker Account.

Proof of education in the **OSHA Blood Borne Pathogens Standard**, and at least one of the following:

- **Proof of documented, successful completion of a didactic dry needling course** of study consisting of a minimum of 50 hours total and a competency assessment of achievement in its curriculum; or
- **Proof of graduation from an entry-level physical therapy program** that included dry needling instruction consisting of a minimum of 50 hours total and a competency assessment of achievement in its curriculum; or
- **Proof of graduation from a post-graduate credentialed residency or fellowship** program of study that included dry needling instruction consisting of a minimum of 50 hours total and a competency assessment of achievement in its curriculum.

### Option 1

#### Report a Didactic Dry Needling Course

1. Go to [www.cebroker.com](http://www.cebroker.com) and click **SIGN IN**
2. Once logged in, click on the **+ REPORT CE** button
3. Under the **Report CE/CME** tab, locate the reporting option **Dry Needling Education**, and click **BEGIN**
4. You will be asked to indicate the 1) name of the course, 2) the name of the provider who presented the course, and 3) how the course was approved, ie: APTA, FSBPT, CAPTE, PTAG or any other state chapter
5. **Documentation Required:** Please be prepared to upload proof of completion of a didactic dry needling course

### Options 2 + 3

Report proof of graduation from an *entry-level physical therapy program* **-OR-** *post-graduate credentialed residency or fellowship program* that included at least 50 hours of dry needling instruction

1. Go to [www.cebroker.com](http://www.cebroker.com) and click **SIGN IN**
2. Once logged in, click on the + **REPORT CE** button
3. Under the **Additional Options** tab, depending on the type of program you completed, locate the correct reporting option, (Graduation from entry level PT program including dry needling **-OR-** Graduation from post-graduate program including dry needling), and click **BEGIN**
4. You will be asked to indicate the 1) college/university that presented this program, and 2) confirm that the program included at least 50 hours of dry needling instruction
5. **Documentation Required:** Please be prepared to upload proof of education in the OSHA Blood Borne Pathogens Standard, **AND** proof of graduation from a physical therapy program that included dry needling.

**If you completed your Dry Needling hours from an entry level - or - post graduate physical therapy program during the biennium for which you are reporting, you can also receive credit for those hours. Simply report them as "Academic Credit" under the "Report CE" tab.**

### How to report an OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens course

1. Go to [www.cebroker.com](http://www.cebroker.com) and click **SIGN IN**
2. Once logged in, click on the + **REPORT CE** button
3. Under the **Report CE/CME** tab, locate the reporting option **OSHA Blood Borne Pathogens Standard**, and click **BEGIN**
4. You will be asked to indicate the 1) name of the course, 2) the name of the provider who presented the course, and 3) how the course was approved, ie: APTA, FSBPT, CAPTE, PTAG or any other state chapter
5. **Documentation Required:** Please be prepared to upload proof of completion of an OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens course

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
