Reinstatement Fee: When a license lapses in a current renewal year and a reinstatement application is received during the 5 month period after the late renewal period has ended (August. 1 through December 31) of that same current renewal year, the application fee will be \$150.00+ \$10.00 processing fee. If the reinstatement application is received after December 31st, the application fee will be \$150.00+ \$10.00 processing fee, plus the reinstatement fee will be \$250.00 per calendar year, or fraction thereof since the license lapsed. The Reinstatement Fee is in addition to the Application Fee and will not be pro-rated. **All fees are non-refundable.**

Secure and Verifiable Documents Under O.C.G.A. § 50-36-2
Issued August 1, 2011 by the Office of the Attorney General, Georgia
